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III. Program Reports

A. Softball/Baseball

1. Baseball

- Spring season has concluded.
- Summer League begins next week.
- Games will be held on **Tuesdays (Home)** and **Saturdays (Away)**.

2. Girls Softball

- End-of-season party scheduled for this evening at Riverside Park for all levels.

3. T-Ball

- Season has concluded; end-of-year celebration was successful.
- Fall Ball will consist of **4 teams** with **46 total registrations**.
- Games will be played on **Mondays and Fridays**.
- Shirts are scheduled to be ordered.

4. Over 35 Softball League

- The traditional four teams continue to participate.
 - Season is progressing smoothly despite early rainouts.
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B. Tennis

- Enrollment limits were adjusted due to management challenges from previous seasons.
 - Groups of 30 participants per age division proved difficult to administer.
 - Program continues to receive strong turnout.
 - Summer session includes both teen and adult lessons.
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C. Pickleball

- Program remains highly popular and well attended.
 - Evening lessons were reinstated due to high demand.
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D. Pop Warner Football & Cheer

- Registration period concluded at the end of May.
 - Report card collection occurred this evening.
 - The **8U team** is currently the only level at full capacity; all other divisions are nearing maximum enrollment.
 - Season is scheduled to begin **August 1**.
 - **96 cheerleading registrations** have been received to date.
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IV. Parks and Playgrounds Updates

- Continued vandalism issues reported at Columbus Park, including missing bricks from the lattice structure. A meeting is scheduled to discuss lighting and camera installation.
 - Several aging park signs will be replaced.
 - Baseball fields at Columbus, Day, and Quibbletown Parks remain scheduled for fall renovation.
 - Sod at Irishtown has fully settled and is now ready for use.
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V. Community Center Report

- The Executive Director of Facilities will be departing at the end of the month; replacement search will commence.
- Summer Camp is at full capacity each week, serving **120 children**.
- The Spray Park continues to experience heavy attendance.
