Dear M.A.,

The Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office first received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) requests on August 1, 2023. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your requests is August 10, 2023. I am responding on the sixth (6) business day.

Pursuant to your request, you have requested:

All reports, logs, incident logs/reports, notes (generated or obtained) from incident/suicide at 201 Woodline Ct, Mullica Hill, NJ on 12/29/2022. To include, but not limited to, all file documents from Investigator/Detective #1894 in reference to their dispatch call on 12/29/2022 at 02:29:03 or any subsequent Investigator/Detective of the Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office that generated any documents referencing the above incident/suicide at 201 Woodline Court, Mullica Hill, NJ

A search of our records has identified only one document, which is a report of Criminal Investigation/Prosecution notification form. No other requested records were identified in our office. Your request for all reports is hereby denied. The requested record(s) or portions thereof are not required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file and pertain to a criminal investigation and are therefore exempt from disclosure pursuant to the criminal investigatory records exception of OPRA. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1; *Paff v. Ocean County Prosecutor's Office*, 235 N.J. 1 (2018); *North Jersey Media Group, Inc. v. Township of Lyndhurst*, 229 N.J. 541 (2017); *Schulz v. N.J. State Police*, Complaint No. 2014-390 (GRC 2015).

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfulfilled within these seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court. The County of Gloucester complies with all state and federal rules and regulations against discrimination in admission to, access to, or operations of its programs, services, and activities. In addition, County encourages participation of people with disabilities in its programs and activities and offers special services to all residents 60 years of age and older. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
