Narrative

On Sunday September 19th, 2021, at approximately 1933 hours, I Ptl. Seehausen #416 responded to 144 Coles Way for a third party report of an individual operating a white Nissan SUV bearing Florida registration QYYS96, allegedly offering children candy.

I arrived and immediately checked the area of Coles Way and Towers St, unable to locate the vehicle in question. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] As I was speaking with her, Ptl. Mandelbaum #420 had found the vehicle in question on Cabernet Dr and Prospect St and was speaking with the driver.

[REDACTED] stated she was unsure when exactly the incident occurred, however sometime earlier today [REDACTED] on Washington Ave near Coles Way when a black male with a short beard driving a white vehicle pulled up next to the playground. [REDACTED] then stated the male, while seated in his vehicle, said "Hey guys.". [REDACTED] stated she ran away immediately, because she was unfamiliar with who he was. When asked if [REDACTED] heard the male say anything else, she denied. [REDACTED] stated only that male was in the vehicle, and he never left the vehicle nor attempted to follow them.

I then walked to 144 Coles Way to speak with the original caller. At the door, I met with Elysse Lerner, who resides there and advised me that she contacted 911. Ms. Lerner stated she heard [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] around 1500 hours today. [REDACTED] came to the door and stated she also observed a bearded male with light brown skin stop his vehicle near the playground. [REDACTED] then stated she heard the male say, "Hey guys.", however did not hear anything else from the male. [REDACTED] also stated that at no point did the male get out of the vehicle, nor did he follow them. Ms. Lerner would state that a juvenile [REDACTED] named [REDACTED] was involved, because he ran up to the vehicle and took a photograph of the vehicle. However Ms. Lerner contacted his mother and when asked what [REDACTED] witnessed, [REDACTED] got on the phone and stated he did not hear the male say anything and only took the photograph because the male was not from the neighborhood due to his complexion.

After I left from 144 Coles Way, Ptl. Mandelbaum #420 contacted me via cellphone and advised me that the male in question, identified as Julio Rivas, is a delivery driver and was dropping off deliveries to 332 Coles Way. Ptl. Mandelbaum furthermore stated that Mr. Rivas was approached by multiple children, who began asking him why he was in the area.

I went to 332 Coles Way to confirm Mr. Rivas' story. At the door I met with resident Chana Gerstel, when I began asking about her receiving a delivery today. Ms. Gerstel stated she received a delivery earlier today that she was expecting from Trendsettings located at 361 Cedarbridge Ave. Ms. Gerstel identified the delivery driver as a Hispanic male, who did not appear to be unusual or suspicious in nature. Ms. Gerstel also stated the delivery driver mentioned being lost in the neighborhood because his GPS had not updated 332 Coles Way, and instead brought him to somewhere else in the neighborhood. I confirmed this by looking up "332 Coles Way" in my GPS, which directed me to 219 Coles Way.

After confirming that no other juveniles were involved in the incident, and unable to locate any cameras that would have captured the incident near the playground, I cleared from the scene.
