On 2/7/12 at about 0904 Hours, I was conducting uniformed motorized patrol duties in marked police vehicle #3390. I was dispatched to Coles Way and Towers St for a vandalism in the past. Upon my arrival, I spoke with the complainant identified as Matt Gross. An unknown actor spray painted the new retaining located at the Coles Way project, which is located on the Northeast side of the project closest to Spruce St. The actor used Red spray paint writing in large letters TE AMO LUPE(I LOVE LUPE) and a heart was after LUPE.

Matt stated that the actor might be someone on a framing crew but there are four different framing crews. Matt is requesting additional patrol checks of the area if it is available. The property damage could be under \$500.00 if he can remove it without taking down the wall. If the wall has to be replaced, the property damage could be as high as \$10,000.00. The area spray painted is not accessible by vehicle without four wheel drive.
