As you are aware, the Office of Emergency Medical Services (OEMS) is currently conducting an audit on South River EMS. As such, you met with investigators on May 24, 2018 where a number of documents were requested including, but not limited to Standard operating procedures, staff roster, staff credentials, billing statements, financial records, etc. To date, OEMS has yet to receive anything from your organization. Please understand that failure to comply will constitute hindering an investigation and will result in action being taken against your provider license, up to summary suspension. If a summary suspension is issued, all operations will cease immediately and OEMS will arrange for coverage to be provided until such time we can ensure there is not an immediate threat to public health, safety and welfare.

It is imperative that all documentation be submitted no later than close of business this Friday, June 15, 2018. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact me. Thank you for your cooperation.
