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AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1-2018

WHEREAS, the Borough of South River ("Borough") directs calls for emergency services from its residents to various first aid squads throughout the Borough, including the South River Rescue Squad and South River Emergency Medical Services, Inc.

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the South River Rescue Squad (the "Squad") has failed to adequately and completely respond to calls for emergency services throughout the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the result of the actions of the Squad members and officers place in jeopardy the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, upon further investigation by the Borough, it has been determined that the Squad's leadership is responsible for the failure to respond to emergency service calls throughout the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the evident systemic deficiencies pose an ongoing and continuing threat to the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough;

WHEREAS, on July 02, 2018, Mayor John M. Krenzel signed Executive Order No. 1-2018 which provides as follows: (1) The Borough will hereinafter direct all calls between 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. for emergency services arising out of the Borough to Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, who will be dispatched from the South River Police Department, 61 Main Street, South River, New Jersey; (2) No further calls for emergency services are to be directed to the South River Rescue Squad; and (3) The Borough will continue at this time to direct calls between 6:01 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. for emergency services out of the Borough to South River Emergency Medical Services, Inc., 6 Thomas Street, South River, New Jersey.

Accordingly, I, Mayor John M. Krenzel do hereby Amend Executive Order No. 1-2018 that the following policies be implemented with respect to requests for emergency services:

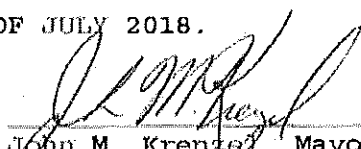
1. The Borough will hereinafter direct all calls between 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. for emergency services arising out of the Borough to Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, who will be dispatched



from the South River Police Department, 61 Main Street, South River, New Jersey; and

2. No further calls for emergency services are to be directed to the South River Rescue Squad.
3. The Borough will continue at this time to direct calls between 6:01 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. for emergency services out of the Borough to South River Emergency Medical Services, Inc., 6 Thomas Street, South River, New Jersey.
4. In the event that South River Emergency Medical Services, Inc. is unable to provide emergency medical services to the Borough during any time between 6:01 a.m. and 11:59 p.m., or in the event that it is determined that the South River Rescue Squad is seeking to circumvent Executive Order 1-2018 by attempting to provide emergency medical services to the Borough during any time frame, all calls for emergency medical services arising out of the Borough will be directed to Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, who will be dispatched from the South River Police Department, 61 Main Street, South River, New Jersey.
5. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.

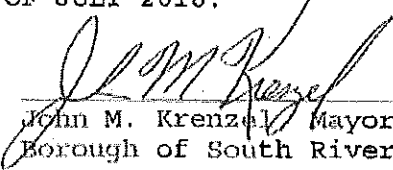
WHEREAS, the evident systemic deficiencies pose an ongoing and continuing threat to the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough;

At the time we felt it would be best to tread lightly and conduct a more thorough investigation once more was exposed. He felt that you might find something more during your investigation that we will certainly follow-up on should the need arise.
