To Ms. Puccio and Dr. Parent,

My son [REDACTED] is a junior. He told me late last week that Spanish Honors 5 will not be offered at GRHS. While I am sure this decision was not made lightly, given the level of competition in applying to colleges, I believe not offering a viable option puts them at disadvantage. Let me explain.

1. I looked at the foreign language requirement in Naviance for the top 66 colleges which include 8 Ivy, 11 State, and 41 Top colleges (6 did not disclose). Have attached the data for your review. The facts are overwhelming:
 - a. All Ivy League colleges except Cornell recommend or require 4 years of a foreign language. Cornell's Arts & Sciences program does require some level of foreign language competency, therefore, these students that do not have some form of language continuity, will be at a disadvantage.
 - b. State schools are mostly between 2 to 3 years recommended or required.
 - c. 56% of top colleges recommend or require 4 years of a foreign language. These are 23 Top schools that are within reach for these students. These are schools that Glen Rock students were accepted in over the past few years.
2. There is a difference between a prerequisite to getting into college and what is needed to graduate from that college. Most Arts and Sciences schools have a foreign language requirement for graduating. By having 4 years of a consistent language which these students were looking for, sets them up to place out of the language requirement. If not, they could be forced to take a placement test whereby they would have to take a certain number of classes until they reach a certain level of proficiency. In many cases these classes are taken without even receiving credit.
3. All of the top schools stress studying abroad. It is in many cases part of the curriculum. Not having a foreign language will limit which programs they can qualify for. This will limit their opportunity.

While I have been impressed with many of the decisions by GRHS, the decision to remove Spanish V honors is perplexing. This short notice decision has presented a significant challenge. My son (I am sure the other kids as well) had carefully planned out his high school schedule as a freshman per the recommendation of the guidance dept. To remove such a core class from the curriculum with the only alternative to move up to AP Spanish is not a fair alternative.

Some thoughts on allowing students to continue Spanish:

- a. Reconsider offering Spanish V Honors. There were 10 kids interested.

- b. Consider offering the class through another town
- c. Consider securing an online class through an accredited school that the students can take.

Hi Michelle,
This is getting better and better every day.
First, my child was disadvantaged last year, because he, being brought up with integrity, went to school on the test days, while most of his classmates were taking tests at home, potentially cheating, and with a help and the comfort.
Then, we had a huge disappointment with Physics AP: the teacher, instead of teaching, gave kids slides to read, resigned, and was replaced by some "virtual" substitute.
Finally, I'm told that my child's transcripts were exposed to the whole world to see.
What am I, as a mother, supposed to do here? Any tips?
Does anyone at the school's administration understands a child's phycological trauma such irresponsible actions could lead to?

It has come to my attention that a folder containing inaccurate transcripts was inadvertently uploaded to Naviance and was subsequently viewable on individual student pages.
