Good morning,

I was told last night that Matt and pat asked one of the employees to come down to the office so that the two of them could speak to him. So Kyle went downstairs as the supervisor and asked what this was about. They told Kyle to get out of the office and asked the other employee why Kyle wanted to know what this was About. Pat than asked do you have any problems with any employees, do you get along with everyone. Do you have a problem with the new hire mike Ayers. Matt parks asked how does he like the job and how's the job going. This employee felt very uncomfortable. This employee is going to be sending me an email regarding this incident. I just wanted to let you guys know that it is getting worse. I know that there is not much you can do right now, but just wanted it noted. Also they told the employee that they will be doing this with every employee. I am not an expert in the laws regarding employee rights but I'm pretty sure that they can't do this. Considering it's only 2 board members and not all of them. When they said that they would be pulling all the employees in to speak to them individually they stated that this was to better south river rescue and south River Ems. I'm trying to do some research and figure out if they are allowed to do this, if an employee can request the supervisor or another employee to be present, if they can say I'm not comfortable talking about this to you.

It also feels as if they are now targeting an employee. They requested to see one employees file after they had questions regarding his emt certification, and what he was doing fixing the printer and going in and out of the supply room. Some employees feel that going rwj 24/7 at this point would probably be the better option. I'm concerned for some employees due to the fact that they do not have other jobs at the moment and this would cause them to loose there job.

My other concern is that matt parks and mike Ayers are requesting the key to the filing cabinet that holds all of the employees personal information such as social security numbers, and direct deposit forms and etc. Is there anyway I can tell them no you can't have a key due to the nature of the documents?

Just an FYI I received a screen shot of an email from Suzanne this morning. They will be doing there last water rescue training October 7th, 2018 at 10:00 am.
