maintain a high moral in the Police Department and to better serve the residents of the Borough of South River,

WHEREAS, be it ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of South River, in the County of Middlesex and the State of New Jersey, to achieve the above purposes and goals, Chapter 47 of the Code of the Borough of South River is amended as follows:

AMEND Section 47-20.5C(1) to read as follows:

(1) Oral Interview. An oral examination shall be conducted for all candidates by an outside agency designated by the Governing Body. The criteria of said outside agency shall be distributed to the candidates ten (10) days before said examination.

AMEND Section 47-20.5C(1d) to read as follows:

The outside agency as designated by the Governing Body shall grade each applicant based upon the criteria as set forth by the outside agency. Said criteria shall be distributed to the candidates ten (10) days before the examination.

AMEND Section 47-20.5C(2) to read a follows.

(2) The Chief of Police will review the following performance-related criteria for each candidate: job related experience, compliance with the rules and regulations of the department, work judgment, quality of work, responsibility, attendance, volume of acceptable work, supervisory evaluation of promotional potential, disciplinary record, accommodations and previous performance. A copy of the form used by the Chief of Police shall be given to each applicant. The Chief shall grade each applicant based on the above criteria. Each of the above listed categories shall be accorded equal weight and scored equally one through nine, with one (1) free point for each individual. By totaling the above scores, each applicant shall be given a numerical score between one (1) to one hundred (100).

ADD: Section 47-20.5C(4)

The education consideration shall take effect January 1, 2003 to allow all current members of the department an opportunity to acquire college credit. Until January 1, 2003, the fifteen (15%) score for education shall be divided between the following promotional elements:

Oral interview	5%
Chief Recommendation	10%

SECTION 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage, approval and publication as is required by law.

Mayor Toto opened the hearing to the public for comment. Eric Gartner stated he is a patrolman in the South River Police Department for ten and one half years and that he understands the reasons behind this ordinance which are to provide a level playing field for all the police officers. He explained that he knows the constraints that are placed on a police officer but he feels cheated by the proposed change in that he went to school to further his college education.

Mr. Gartner stated that this is the fourth change in promotion criteria in the last ten years, adding that it becomes very difficult to prepare for the process. He asked the Governing to reconsider their action before they make a final decision on this Ordinance. He added that this Ordinance tells him that he wasted his time on going to school.

Mr. Gartner stated that we need an Ordinance that will not change over time. He stated that he agrees with the proposal for members of the PBA to sit down with members of the Governing Body to discuss the promotion process criteria.

The being no further comment, Councilwoman Balazs moved that the hearing be closed. Councilman Jones seconded the motion. So carried.

Mayor Toto asked the Council members as to the action to be taken on this Ordinance. Councilman Krenzel moved that the Ordinance be approved and the Clerk authorized to publish same as is required by law. Councilman Jones seconded the motion.

Councilman Haussermann stated that by making certain changes to the promotion criteria at this time is making it unfair to certain police officers. He explained that the Chiefs of Police Association have a written test in addition to oral examination, personnel data, recommendations of the local police chief and interviews by the Governing Body. He added that this Ordinance does not have any criteria for a written examination and in 1995 Mayor Toto sated he would veto such Ordinance does not have a written test. He stated the Mayor is willing to approve this Ordinance.

Mayor Toto stated he is trying to get the Governing Body to adopt some criteria and he agrees with having an oral test, the Chief's evaluation but not Governing Body interviews.

Councilman Haussermann asked if we should consult with the PBA to draw a procedure before we proceed with this Ordinance. Councilman Krenzel recommended that this Ordinance be adopted and that the Public Safety Committee review the PBA's recommendations. Councilman Haussermann asked why should we adopted this Ordinance now. Councilman Krenzel stated that there are too many variable factors to be considered for the entire process. Councilman Haussermann stated that since the police are asking to make changes, why adopt this Ordinance. Councilman Krenzel stated that the Police are looking at a long term process. Councilman Haussermann stated you are rushing ahead with this Ordinance, knowing that you will change it again.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Joseph Brzozowski of 34 Cleveland Avenue stated he would like to voice his concerns about the impact of the proposed 136 single family home development in South River, especially the effect upon the schools. He explained that the homes are to have four bedrooms and at 2.7 children per home a strain will be placed on the school system. He added that the taxes generated will not cover the cost of educating the children nor provide for the county and municipal services.

Mr. Brzozowski stated that this development does not provide any developed recreation area which is also lacking in South River. He explained that the Governing Body has an opportunity to acquire this land through purchase or condemnation and then develop it through a five to seven year plan. He added that recreation facilities are need for our youth and residents, citing the Crystal Springs Aquatic Center in East Brunswick as an example of what can be done.

Councilman Szegeti stated that the Matzel and Mumford survey indicates that seventy (70) children will come from this development during the first five years after its completion. He added that various court decisions do not allow us to use your rational to deny such applications.

Mr. Brzozowski asked if the Borough could acquire this property through condemnation. Mr. Roselli stated he would have to research the existing laws, adding that such action has to be based on the health, safety and/or welfare of the residents.

Mayor Toto stated there is a definite need for additional recreation in town but it will be costly to develop. Mr. Brzozowski asked if the developer can provide some playing fields. Councilman Szegeti stated that the Planning Board can not require such action but the Governing Body might be able to do it through a developer's agreement.

John Mamrak of 57 New Street reminded the Governing Body about an error in the Sentinel Newspaper article concerning the return rate of the clients enrolled in Project Act Now. He stated that eighty-five percent do not return. He explained that Project Act Now fits in with the Borough's DARE program and he is trying to convince both the Borough and the Board of Education to provide the necessary funding so that the program can continue.

Councilman Krenzel asked if the program is looking for \$11,600. Mr. Mamrak stated that is the amount expended in 1997. Mayor Toto stated that we are in the process of putting together our budget and your request will be discussed. Councilman Haussermann stated that the Council/School Board Liaison Committee will be discussing this issue at its next meeting.

Councilman Jones stated that since Mr. Mamrak resigned from the Municipal Alliance, he is doing more work for them. Mr. Mamrak stated he checked into the question if medical insurance providers would pay these costs and was advised they do not.

Andre Trygar of 14 Johnson Place stated she enjoyed the Borough Christmas tree lighting ceremonies this year, adding that the tree was beautifully decorated and place in a more open space for people to see. She recommended that it be placed there next year.

Ann Terenin of 75 Division Street stated she is glad that the Borough created the position of public defender, adding that she supported the state law requiring it by writing letters to the Governor ,state elected officials and the newspapers.

Ms. Terenin stated she has a problem with the shut-off of water at 75 Division Street before Thanksgiving Day. She explained that the property belongs to her 83 year old mother whose only income is from social security. She added that someone in the utility office told her that she could pay the water bill after she received her next social security check but Mr. Clark indicated otherwise.

Ms. Terenin asked that the reconnection fee be waived, adding that her mother has owned the property since 1966 and never had this problem.

Ms. Terenin stated she has joined an organization called Common Cause. She explained that Freeholder Pozycki resigned because he felt he was ineffectual as a Freeholder and joined Common Cause to become one of its directors. She added that he hopes to get more people involved in government.

Ms. Terenin stated that when one party dominates, they impose their will. She added they we need opposing views in resolving issues, even if delays are created. She stated she will wait to see what good Mr. Pozycki will create by his association with Common Cause.

John Scala of 440 Old Bridge Turnpike wished all a very happy new year. He added that during the past holiday he observed a seventy-five percent improvement in garbage not being placed out except for one area on Obert Street, adding he is glad that Councilman Jones had the police issue summons to those who had garbage at the curb on Christmas eve. He stated that Councilman Jones is doing a good job.

Mayor Toto stated that he was in the Borough Hall when someone complained about being issued such a violation notice.

Mr. Scala stated that on December 15th, South River was on WCTC and one of the topic was the lack of sidewalks on lower Whitehead Avenue for the school children to walk on. He referred to a recent newspaper article which explained the plight of the three children which live in the old Kuberski homestead. He stated that Whitehead Avenue has a lot of heavy truck traffic in this area but fortunately someone donated a car to this family so that they do not have to walk in the street. He added that Assemblywoman Buono and Senator Vitale were to check into the situation to see if bussing is required but Dr. Ambrosia did call and advise that this family does live beyond the mandatory bussing distance.

Mr. Scala asked what is more important than the safety of our children. Both Councilwoman Balazs and Councilman Jones agreed that safety is very important. Councilman Haussermann stated we have many safety issues about which the Council is concerned. Mr. Kolakowski stated that both sharp bends on Whitehead Avenue are to be re-configured under the Matzel and Mumford subdivision application. He added that when the subdivision is completed, the children will be able to use the sidewalks on the subdivision streets and thus avoid Whitehead Avenue except for a small part where there are currently sidewalks.

Mr. Jones stated that we need to emphasize to the Planning Board that sidewalks should be required on all applications. Councilman Szegeti stated that Whitehead Avenue is a county road and the County Planning Board makes the determination, not us.

Councilman Haussermann stated a meeting is to be held with the developer at which he will push for sidewalks on Whitehead Avenue from Kann Avenue to Wojcie Way. Mr. Scala stated that not replacing the sidewalks in the downtown business area will not hurt the businesses.

Mayor Toto stated that he spoke with a number of business owners who advised him that business was up on the day of the car rally/craft fair. He added that as to the effect of new sidewalks, we will have to wait and see.

Mr. Scala questioned if the State will pay the costs for having a public defender since they mandated it. He questioned what the rate of pay is to be and if we can combine this position with those of another town or more. Councilman Krenzel stated the rate of pay has not been decided at this time and regionalizing the service should be examined.

Mr. Scala stated he noticed that there is an electrical contractor do work in Lincoln School. Mr. Kolakowski stated TV-35 is being moved there and the we have to expand the electric service for the studio.

Mr. Scala stated that there is a drainage problem on Southside Avenue and Yates Avenue. Mr. Kolakowski stated that the Borough Engineer has been asked to look at the drainage in this area and the possibility of diverting the water into the storm drains on Jeffrey Avenue.

Patrick Horton, Superintendent of the Village Green Apartment, complained about the school kids using this complex as a short cut to Hillside Avenue, adding they are breaking windows and littering. He explained that he spends considerable efforts to make the apartment complex look nice. Mayor Toto stated he will have the Police Chief look into this matter.
