Re: Open Public Records Act/Common Law Records Request

Dear FratLawz:

The Borough of Glassboro Records Custodian received your request for records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act (OPRA) and the New Jersey common law right of access, dated March 18, 2023, via email on March 20, 2023, and forwarded your request to the Police Records Sub-Custodian for a response as to Items 2 and 3 for police records. Accordingly, the initial seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request under OPRA was March 29, 2023. By correspondence dated March 29, 2023, we responded to Item 2 of your request as to police records and requested a seven (7) business day extension, until April 7, 2023, to further process your request as to Item 3. Due to the April 7 legal holiday, this supplemental response as to Item 3 is being provided on this date.

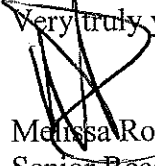

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Glassboro to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All

questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
