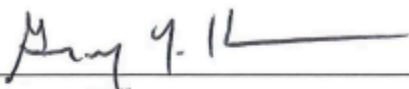
The official Records Custodian for Sea Girt Elementary School, Greg Hillman, received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on January 28, 2025. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is February 6, 2025. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 3rd business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

The table below identifies the records that are denied in whole or in part as well as the legal basis for each denial, as is required by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-6.

Legal explanation and statutory citation for the denial of access to records in their entirety.
"Electronic copy of the anonymous letter cited in January 23, 2025 agenda sect. X Number 3, page 5." <u>N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1.</u> Inter-agency or intra-agency advisory, consultative or deliberative material This matter is currently being investigated. <u>N.J.S.A. 47:1A-9.a.</u> (allows exemptions from disclosure contained in other state statutes to apply under OPRA) <u>N.J.S.A. 10:4-12</u> (allows governing bodies to exclude the public from discussions of personnel matters).

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Sea Girt Elementary School to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
