Narrative

08/13/2024
On the above date I was dispatched to 1401 Marne Highway, Hainesport Township, Burlington County, reference a Attempt to Locate, that was later turned over to a Domestic Investigation. NJSP dispatch "5 Comm" advised responding Troopers that the reporting party later identified as Ms. Linda Hasner stated she was being followed by her ex-husband and co-parent, later identified as Mr. Douglas Reynolds. It should be noted that Ms. Hasner has a permanant restraining order (FRO) against Mr. Reynolds, which prohibits such actions. Ms. Hasner stated to "5 comm" that she also believed Mr. Reynolds to be in possession of a weapon, and that she had her five (5) year old son with her. Upon arrival I met with Ms. Hasner who stated that Mr. Reynolds was no

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longer following her and that she saw him turn off onto Fostertown Road, in Hainesport Township, Burlington County. Ms. Hasner stated that while in the area of State Highway 38, she observed a vehicle that she believed to be owned by Mr. Reynolds and a driver who resembled Mr. Reynolds following her on State Highway 38. Ms. Hasner stated that she was transporting her son from a day camp where he required pick up reference a medical emergency. Ms. Hasner stated that her son was picked up and that she was going to transport him to Mount Holly Virtua Hospital for evaluation and treatment. It should be noted that upon observing Ms. Hasner's son, he appeared to be in good health and well-being. Ms. Hasner stated that she later decided to not transport her son due to no immediate medical need, and to later bring him to his primary physician on a later date. Ms. Hasner stated that this emergency also took place around the time that her son's custody was supposed to be transferred over to Mr. Reynolds. Ms. Hasner stated that this transfer of custody was supposed to take place at Lumberton Police Department. Ms. Hasner stated she called Lumberton Police and advised them of the medical emergency, and the fact that she would not be able to transfer custody at this time.

It should be noted that Ms. Hasner also has a private investigator later identified as Mr. Paul Blaiso who would be able to assist with the investigation. When asked about the communication in regards to the transfer of custody, Ms. Hasner stated that she uses a court supervised application on her phone, which she stated Mr. Reynolds does not cooperate with. Ms. Hasner stated that Mr. Reynolds has communicated with her via text message in violation of the FRO in place. This violation was reported to and acted upon by Mount Laurel Police Department by Officer Prinkley #182 (Report #202432874). Ms. Hasner stated that she wanted this incident documented and wanted to pursue a criminal complaint for stalking. Ms. Hasner also provided a photograph from behind the suspected vehicle to document its location in her proximity. Ms. Hasner stated that at some point while in transit she was able to get behind the suspected vehicle. Ms. Hasner then stated that the suspected vehicle pulled over and resumed its position behind her. In the photograph no driver or vehicle registration could be observed. Ms. Hasner was provided a voluntary statement form, which could not be completed due to her son acting out and her having parental conflicts. At this time Ms. Hasner was provided the investigating Troopers email address to send the form via email once it was completed.

I contacted Mount Laurel Police department and spoke with Officer Prinkley who confirmed the report and confirmed that he spoke with Ms. Hasner in regards to this criminal complaint as well.

08/16/2024

On the above date I contacted Mr. Reynolds via telephone. Mr. Reynolds was asked about his whereabouts on the previously mentioned date, to which he

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stated "is this about Linda?". Mr. Reynolds was advised as to the reason for the call and was asked about his itenary. Mr. Reynolds stated that he was at Lumberton Police Station, to receive custody of his son from Ms. Hasner. Mr. Reynolds stated that he was advised by a Lumberton Police Officer about the medical emergency his son was experiencing. Mr. Reynolds stated that he was then en route to the hospital to confirm the well-being of his child. Mr. Reynolds then stated he saw Ms. Hasner's vehicle and began following the vehicle to get to the hospital. Mr. Reynolds then noticed Ms. Hasner's vehicle no longer heading in the direction of the hospital, and then contacted Lumberton Police for advisement. Mr. Reynolds was then advised he would be in violation of his FRO if he continued to follow Ms. Hasner's vehicle, at this point Mr. Reynolds turned off and headed home.

I then contacted Lumberton Police department and spoke with Officer Justin Simboli #13 who stated he was the officer responsible for the interaction between Ms. Hasner and Mr. Reynolds. Officer Simboli stated that around the hours of 1600 Ms. Hasner called stating she did not feel safe handing over her son to Mr. Reynolds, and that her son was experiencing a allergic reaction. Ms. Hasner then stated she was going to be en route to the hospital. Officer Simboli stated that another officer advised Mr. Reynolds of the medical emergency. Officer Simboli stated that Mr. Reynolds then called later in time and asked why Ms. Hasner's vehicle was no longer heading in the direction of the hospital. Officer Simboli advised Mr. Reynolds to stop following the vehicle and to report the incident to his local police department, because his action could be in violation of his FRO. Officer Simboli stated that Mr. Reynolds stated he understood and advised him, he stoppedped following her and was heading home.

Ms. Hasner's investigator Mr. Blaiso was contacted in reference to the investigation and same stated that he saw nothing to support a criminal complaint.

Due to a lack of evidential material to support a criminal complaint this case will be deemed unfounded and closed. If any additional evidence is discovered this case will be reopened.
