The Borough of Woodstown Official Records Custodian, Patricia Bohren, received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on July 9th, 2026. The request has been forwarded to the Woodstown Police Department on July 14th, 2026, as we are the custodian of the requested record. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is July 20th, 2026. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 3rd business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request.

1. NJTR-1 Crash Report (Case #26WB2963, 3 pages)

These records are being transmitted to you via email, as per your request.

Please note that your request for "Police Crash Incident Reports" was interpreted to mean New Jersey NJTR-1 Crash Reports, which have been provided. If this interpretation is not correct, please respond by July 19th, 2026 with clarification.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Woodstown Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
