Our office received a complaint from a Ms. Daisy Freeman that in November 2012 your business removed an oil tank from the above referenced address. During this removal process, oil was spilled onto the ground and was not cleaned up properly.

Workers who were completing the job for converting oil to gas notified the owner of the property that an oil spill, from when the tank was removed needed to be cleaned up. This Contractor notified the State of this spill and then the State notified Ms. Freeman that this contaminated soil must be removed.
