Successful Use of Social Media for Criminal Investigations

The New Jersey Regional Intelligence Academy (RIA) will be hosting a two-day course called the *Successful Use of Social Media for Criminal Investigations*, **October 24-25, 2019** from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM at the Middlesex County Fire Academy, 1001 Fire Academy Dr, Sayreville, NJ 08872.

There is **no cost** to attend, but pre-registration is required. This course is designed for intelligence analysts, special agents, and other investigators.

Instructor: This class will be taught by Chuck Cohen, an Adjunct Professor and Indiana State Police Captain who leads an Internet Crimes Against Children taskforce.

Description: There are currently over 300 English language social networking sites on the Internet. Too often, investigators and analysts overlook or underutilize these valuable resources. Social networking sites are virtual communities and as in any large community, criminal organizations, fraud, violent crime, and victimization exist. Investigators and analysts need to understand these communities along with the tools, tricks, and techniques to prevent, track, and solve crimes.

Significant attention will be given to the use of social media by terrorists and those wishing to recruit for terrorist activities. Students will learn what information is available on various sites and how to integrate that information into criminal investigations and criminal intelligence analysis.

Students with any level of familiarity with the Internet and computers, from beginning to advanced, will find this course beneficial. The program gives students an up-to-date understanding of how social networking sites work and how members act and interact.
