May 12, 2020 – Council Authorized RVE at their Council Meeting for the Permit Phase of the project (Resolution No. 2020-89)

May 18, 2020 – RVE began preparation of the NJDEP Flood Hazard and General Wetlands Permit Application including plans and reports

May 27, 2020 – RVE Requested Natural Heritage Data Request

June 18, 2020 – Hand Delivered the NJDEP LURP (Application) Form to the Mayor to obtain signature from the Homa Family

June 25, 2020 – Calculated property owners list within 200 feet (required for notice to the property owners of the application)

July 2, 2020 – Received Natural Heritage Data Base

July 8, 2020 – Requested certification of property owners list to Borough Tax Assessor

July 11, 2020 – Received certified property owners list from Borough Tax Assessor

July 24, 2020 – Completed Reports and Plan for NJDEP Applications

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
