Restoration Grant Program

The National Fish and Wildlife Foundation will award 40-50 grants of \$20,000 to \$50,000 to local partners to develop community capacity to sustain natural resources focused on improving water quality and watersheds.

Deadline: January 28, 2021

Eligible applicants include non-profit 501(c) organizations, state government agencies, local governments, municipal governments, Indian tribes and educational institutions.

Resilience Grant Program

The National League of Cities will award eight \$10,000 grants and ongoing technical assistance to cities to support capacity among elected leaders, government staff, and community-based organizations as they pursue coordinated climate resilience efforts.

Deadline: December 23, 2020

Eligible applicants include cities and towns with a population of 5,000 or more. Cities are strongly encouraged to partner with a community-based organization or local nonprofit.
