SUPPORTING PRESERVING THE SERGEANSTVILLE POST OFFICE**

WHEREAS, the Sergeantsville Post Office was established in 1827 with the First Postmaster General being duly sworn on March 3, 1827; and

WHEREAS, since 1827 the Post Office has had only three locations with its current location being established on March 12, 1966: and

WHEREAS, since 1827 the Sergeantsville Post Office has served and continues to serve residents and is integral to the community; and

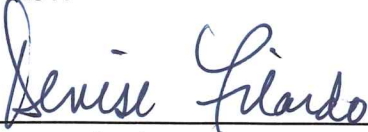
WHEREAS, since 1966 the Sergeantsville Post Office has served as the heart of the community at the current location where residents conduct their postal business, gather, and learn about issues and news pertaining to the Delaware Township community; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Township Committee strongly opposes any plan to close the Sergeantsville Post Office to a new location; and

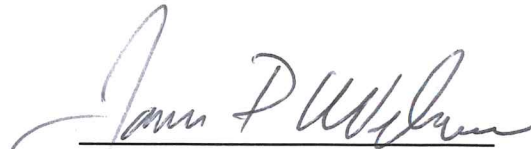
WHEREAS no transition plan has been established which shall cause major disruption of Postal Services to the community; and
