

BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL:

WHEREAS, Richard Moody, City Engineer, has requested the temporary closure of Church Street from Kirkpatrick Street to Spring Street and the closure of a section of Spring Street bounded by Albany Street and Church Street in order to provide safer pedestrian and traffic flows to accommodate the demolition of the Ferren Deck by the New Brunswick Parking Authority; and

WHEREAS, said request has been reviewed by the members of the City Council who approve the following temporary amendments to be effective October 20, 2016 for a period of up to two (2) years unless otherwise determined by the office of the City Engineer to be no longer needed provided that at the end of the two (2) years or when determined by the City Engineer, notice shall be provided to the public by publication in the official City newspaper.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the New Brunswick City Council that the following closures are hereby approved:

1. **Church Street Closure:** Starting at westerly curb line, of the southwest corner of the Church Street and Spring Street intersection, and extending westerly along Church Street for approximately 330 feet.
2. **Spring Street Closure:** Starting at the northerly curb line, of the northeast corner of the Church Street and Spring Street intersection, and extending northerly along Spring Street for approximately 230 feet.

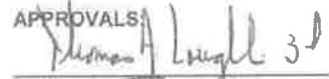
