**ADDENDUM OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS AUTHORIZING
AMENDMENT AND EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY SHARED SERVICE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WOODBURY AND THE BOROUGH OF
WOODBURY HEIGHTS REGARDING TEMPORARY POLICE DEPARTMENT
SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights and the City of Woodbury heretofore entered into a Temporary Shared Services Agreement regarding Police Department administrative and police protection services; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. ("Shared Services Law") specifically authorizes local government units, including counties and municipalities, to enter into Shared Services Agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Woodbury and the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The City of Woodbury and the Borough of Woodbury Heights do hereby approve and authorize the execution of an Addendum extending the Temporary Shared Service Agreement between the City of Woodbury and the Borough of Woodbury Heights regarding Police Department services for an additional period of ninety (90) days commencing on May 20, 2023.
2. The Temporary Shared Services Agreement originally entered in May 2022 providing for administrative services by the City of Woodbury Chief of Police,

as well as police coverage and protection services by the Officers of the City of Woodbury Police Department is amended to reflect that any Officer within the City of Woodbury Police Department that fills a shift for a patrol within the Borough of Woodbury Heights due to manpower shortages or emergencies within the Borough shall be compensated at a rate of no less than \$70.00/hr. or the Officers overtime rate, whichever is higher.

3. That the Mayor and Borough Officials be and are hereby authorized to execute the Addendum to the Temporary Shared Service Agreement on behalf of the Borough of Woodbury Heights.
