Re: Township of Clark OPRA Requests – Responses to NBC

Dear NJPRA/Anonymous:

The Township of Clark received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on June 7, 2022. The official Records Custodian, Edith Merkel, received your OPRA request on June 7, 2022. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is June 16, 2022. This response to your request is being provided to you on the Second business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

- Responses sent by the Township of Clark since 1/1/22 to all requests made by any employee or representative of NBC or NBC Universal in reference to Joseph Teston, Pedro Matos, Vincent Concina and Antonio Manata's employment with the Township.

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request:

- Response to April 4, 2022 NBC request (33 pages);
- Response to April 7, 2022 NBC request (56 pages); and
- Response to May 24, 2022 NBC request (15 pages).

A list of OPRA's exemptions is attached to this response letter.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Clark to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
