Dear Sir/Madam:

On behalf of the Monroe Township Board of Education ("Board" and/or "District"), I am writing this letter in furtherance of my correspondence dated June 25, 2025, in response to your request for records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act ("OPRA") submitted and received via email on Monday, June 16, 2025.

OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time within which to respond, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5. Specifically, the OPRA states that, in the event a records custodian needs additional time to fulfill the request, the custodian shall be entitled to a reasonable extension of time and shall notify the requester of the time extension. In regards to your request, this office requested such an extension until Thursday, July 3, 2025. Accordingly, the Board's response to your request is set forth below.

"1) All resumes on file for Kenneth Chanley".

As a preliminary matter, please be advised the OPRA provides that "...a public agency has a responsibility and an obligation to safeguard from public access a citizen's personal information with which it has been entrusted when disclosure thereof would violate the citizen's reasonable expectation of privacy..." N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1. Redactions of personal email addresses, personal cellular telephone numbers and home addresses are permissible means by which an individual's reasonable privacy expectations may be protected. See Scheeler v. New Jersey Dep't of Educ., 2017 WL 218259, at 4 (App. Div. 2017); Doe v. Poritz, 142 N.J. 82 (1995) (holding that the public disclosure of an individual's home address

implicates OPRA's privacy concerns); D'Andrea v. N.J. Civil Service Comm'n, GRC Complaint No. 2014-153 (2015) (holding that personal email addresses can be redacted); Flora v. Ocean County Health Dep't, GRC Complaint No. 2013-188 (2015) (personal cell numbers may be redacted to protect citizen's privacy interests).

In accordance with the above, enclosed please find the resume of Kenneth Chanley which has been redacted to protect confidential personal information pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.

"2) Copy of all certifications held by Kenneth Chanley".

The OPRA only permits the production of records which disclose conformity with specific experiential, educational or medical qualifications which are required for employment are also disclosable. See N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10; N.J.A.C. 6A:32-4.3; N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b)(8); Libertarians for Transparent Government v. Cumberland County, 250 N.J. 46 (2022); Wagner v. Twp. of Montclair Police Dep't. (Essex), GRC Complaint No. 2013-222 (March 2014); Bonanno v. Garfield Bd. of Educ. Bus. Dep't, GRC Complaint No. 2006-62 (March 2007).

In accordance with the above, enclosed please find the certification of Kenneth Chanley required for employment, which has been redacted to protect confidential personal information pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.

As the documents identified above are being provided to you in electronic format only, there is no charge associated with your request. The correspondence, the foregoing information, and the enclosed documents constitute the Board's full and complete response to your OPRA request and therefore, your OPRA request is closed.
