Dear Ms. Redpath-Perez:

The County of Salem received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on June 15, 2022. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request was June 27, 2022, with an extension granted to July 8, 2022. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 13th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

"Records Requested: The RFP for psychiatric services at the Salem County Jail, 2017-present. The award of contract same time frame."

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request: RFP and Resolution Awards for psychiatric services at the Salem County Jail for 2017, 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022. Please note there is only a Resolution Award for the year of 2018.

These records are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the County of Salem to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
