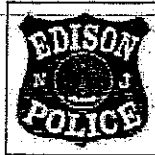

SIR in follow up to 18058812-1 prepared and submitted by Ptl Cipolla on 9/27/18.

On Thursday, 9/27/18, I was assigned to investigate this incident by Det Sgt T Duffy who provided me a hard copy of the above listed IR.

Upon review of Ptl Cipolla's IR I learned the following: On Tuesday, 9/25/18, at approx 1730 hours, Grace Lepping was shopping in Walgreen's (905 New-Durham Ave). It was during this time that Lepping's wallet was stolen from her. On 9/27/18 she was notified that the credit cards contained inside of her stolen wallet were fraudulently being used at Macy's in the Menlo Park Mall.

In that incident (18058797), a female and male suspect later identified as Kachae Jackson and Richard Mims were attempting to use Lepping's credit cards to make approx \$5000 in purchases. They fled the scene when confronted by Macy's Loss Prevention and prior to police arrival. While fleeing Jackson left behind her purse containing her Pennsylvania ID card. Refer to SIR 18058797 for further.

I received security video from Walgreen's during the time frame Lepping reported to have been in the store. Upon review of the video, I was unable to locate Lepping and Jackson/Mims in the store. As a result I am unable to charge either with the theft of Leppings wallet.

Complaints approved and authorized for using her cards at Macys (Case 18058797).

Upon arrival, this Officer made contact with reportee Thomas-Bowen. Reportee reports that on the date and time of incident two individuals, both African American one being a 5'1 female with brown skin and black hair and the second one being a 5'8 male with brown skin attempted to purchase Gemstones with a fraudulent Macy's Credit Card under the name of Grace A Lepping with an account number of [REDACTED]

Reportee further reports he was notified by the cashier that the transaction may be fraudulent. As a result the reportee and other involved Helegessen went to the jewelry section in their capacity as Loss Prevention for Macy's. Reportee further reports that once in the jewelry section of Macy's he approached the individuals when that were using the fraudulent credit card and was subsequently accosted by them. During the attempt to flee, suspect Jackson left behind her purse that may have been grabbed by Macy's Loss Prevention. Reportee was able to see that the suspects entered into a black SUV with tinted windows and fled Route One South. Officers in the area checked the immediate vicinity with negative results.

Reportee made contact with the Macy's Cardholder through their fraud department who advised she did not make a purchase. Macy's was able to retrieve their Gemstones at the time of incident that totaled \$2,200.00 and as a result suffered a pecuniary loss of \$0.00.

Property of the suspect identified as Kachae Jackson was turned over to police and inventoried as follows:

one Luis Vuitton Purse, Misc Personal credit cards, one Pennsylvania Drivers License ([REDACTED]), one Apple watch, one pair Gucci Glasses, ten Amoxicillin pills, three Oxycodone Pills and two I-Phone chargers. All of the aforementioned were lodged into evidence.

During a search of the suspects property five fraudulent credit cards under the name of Grace Lepping were located and confiscated and also lodged into evidence. VNF Completed. Evidence form completed. Investigation TOT Detective Wilfredo Brown. Nothing further.

SIR in follow up to IR 18058797-1 prepared and submitted by Ptl Ship on 9/27/18.

On 9/27/18, Det Michalski and I were detailed by Det Sgt T Duffy to Macys, 55 Parsonage Road, on the report of a fraud.

Upon arrival, we met Ptl Ship who through his initial investigation learned the following. On 9/27/18 at approx 1302 hours a black female described approx 5-01 and a black male approx 5-08 attempted to purchase Gemstones with a fraudulent Macys credit card. The name on the credit card belonged to Grace A Lepping. When approached by Macys loss prevention the two suspects fled the area in a black SUV. Refer to Ptl Ships IR for further.

Recovered on scene was a purse containing five credit cards bearing the name of Grace A Lepping. It should be noted that Lepping reported her wallet was stolen containing these credit cards from the Walgreens pharmacy (see case# 18058812).

Also contained inside that purse was a Pennsylvania drivers license belonging to Kachae Jackson [REDACTED]. The photo on this ID matched that of the female suspect. I conducted a look up to verify the information and was able to confirm it was correct.

I was able to review the security video from the incident and observed a black male suspect with a heavy build, short black hair, a long thick black beard.

I searched Jacksons facebook page and was able to locate a male matching that description as Rich Mims. Using this information, I conducted a TLO look up and was able to identify this male as Richard Q Mims [REDACTED]. I returned to Macys and met with Macys Loss prevention employees, Juwaan Thomas-Bowen and Mathew Helegesen. Both of them had direct contact with Jackson and Mims at the time of the incident. I showed them a photo of Mims from his facebook profile. Both Bowen and Helegesen positively identified Mims as the suspect involved during this incident.

While speaking with Helegesen he reported the total value of the merchandise that they were attempting to purchase was valued at \$5,500.

Having properly identified Jackson and Mims, I contacted AP Christopher Fusick to discuss the details of the case.
