The South Brunswick Board of Fire Commissioners for the South Brunswick Fire District No. 3 received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on October 24, 2023. This response is being provided to you on October 25, 2023. Your OPRA request sought access to the following: "Produce all emails, letters, notes that Rob Weissman sent the District Commissioners, either individually or whole group, concerning Kingston Volunteer Fire Company by laws. Also include other not on the Board but were copied".

The following document is submitted in response to your request:

(1) Email dated December 24, 2021 from Rob Weissman to District 3 Commissioner Augustino Racanati and Cheng Lee with attachments (redacted). The redactions include drafts of proposed changes and amendments to the bylaws which are exempt from disclosure as "advisory, consultative, deliberative material" pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 and decisions including Libertarians for Transparent Government v. Government Records Council, 453 N.J. Super 83 (App. Div. 2018) *cert denied* 233 N.J. 484 (2018). The enclosed documents being provided to you total three pages.

The Records Custodian represents and affirms to this office that the enclosed non-privileged documents are the entire documentation relative to your request. If you believe that your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866) 850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their

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web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in the Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your county.
