

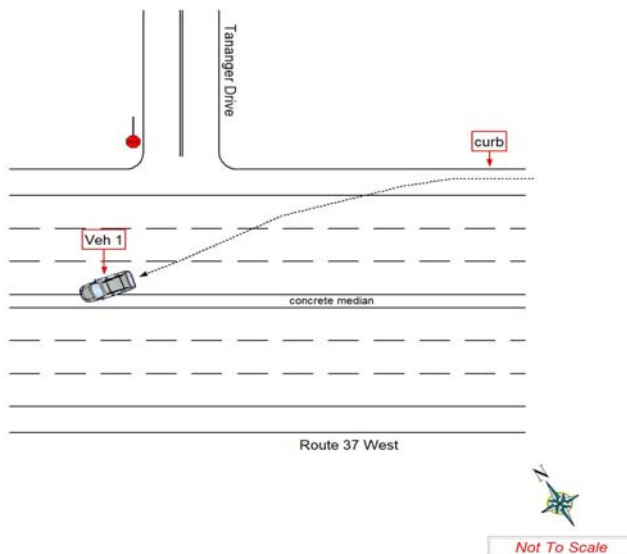

145 Crash Description/Narrative

While driver #1 was attempting to flee from a single-vehicle MV collision that he was involved in at the intersection of Route 37 and Oak Ridge Parkway (20-42541), he attempted to drive his heavily-damaged vehicle west on Route 37. Vehicle #1 had heavy front-end damage, a partially crushed roof from overturning, and several flat tires. Driver #1 struck the curb and went partially off the roadway on the north side of Route 37. He then swerved across all 3 lanes of Route 37 westbound as evidenced by its' tire marks and gouges left from its' vehicle rim. It then collided with the concrete center median that divides the eastbound and westbound lanes of Route 37 with the driver's side front corner of the vehicle. The vehicle became completely disabled after this impact. Arriving officers found driver #1 attempting to climb out of his heavily damaged driver's window frame. He admitted to consuming several beers prior to these two collisions on this date. Several sealed and opened 12 oz. cans of Natural Ice beer were found inside vehicle #1 including 1 can that was wedged in a cupholder near the driver's seat. Driver #1 was issued numerous traffic tickets associated with the original crash.
