Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:
On February 2, 2025, at 1843 hours, the victim arrived at police headquarters to report an assault that took place at [REDACTED] in Beachwood on January 31, 2025, at about 2200 hours. While speaking to the victim, he advised he was hanging out at [REDACTED] when the defendant was also there. The victim stated the defendant was intoxicated and attacked him. The victim stated the defendant punched him in the face knocking him unconscious and then continued to punch him in the face causing his right cheekbone and eye socket to become broken. After speaking to the victim, I spoke to three witnesses. The first witness, K.D. stated the defendant first attacked the victim inside her residence and then continued outside her residence. K.D. stated she observed the defendant punch the victim multiple times. The second witness was B.S. who was reported to also be assaulted but was indicating he was not at the residence and only heard that the defendant assaulted the victim and sent the victim to the hospital. The third witness, N.Z. stated he was at the residence and observed the defendant intoxicated and being aggressive. N.Z. stated he then left the residence because the "defendant was getting out of hand". Based on the victims' injuries and witness statements and speaking with AP Kelly probable cause was found to charge the defendant with aggravated assault.
