1. I am employed as a DETECTIVE with the BEACHWOOD POLICE DEPT.
2. In the course of my duties I have had occasion to investigate (state all indictable charges you are signing for which this affidavit applies):

Aggravated Assault, Conspiracy to commit Robbery & Robbery

3. I have probable cause to believe that Saheed Bahlouli committed the above offense(s).

4. I am charging the defendant with SAME AS ABOVE based on the following proof.

September 5, 2016 BWPD officers responded to an address on [REDACTED] where a male reported being assaulted and robbed of a cell phone, us currency, bank card and identification. The male identified the actors as males who were walking the streets with him and identified by police just 15 minutes prior to the robbery. The males were identified as Saheed Bahloui, Christopher Jones and Rodney Smith. During the course of the investigation it was learned that Dayna Bell called the victim, [REDACTED] to Beachwood to meet with her so

the three males could assault him and steal his belongings. The victim received a large laceration on his right forehead, swollen right cheek with smaller lacerations and cuts / bruising and pain to his ribs. The victim was treated at CMC and released with multiple stitches to his head to close the large laceration.

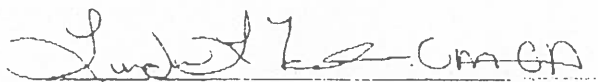
