

RESOLUTION R.459-082018

EXPLANATION: A Resolution providing the Municipal Council's advice and consent to the re-appointment by the Mayor of Maureen Ruane as Township Business Administrator.

WHEREAS, the Township of Edison (the "Township") is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey and seeks to re-appoint its Business Administrator to serve as head of its Department of Administration ("Department"); and

WHEREAS, the Business Administrator shall be responsible for the administration, direction, coordination, supervision and control of all divisional units of the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Township ("Municipal Council") has reviewed the qualifications and service of Maureen Ruane as Business Administrator, including her education, training, experience and certifications, and found her both highly experienced and suitable to be re-appointed to this position; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor desires to re-appoint Maureen Ruane as Business Administrator for the reasons set forth herein, and recommends waiver of the residency requirement in the Township Charter, Section 3-14, Township Code Section 2-21(a), and in accordance with *N.J.S.A. 40:69A-44*; and

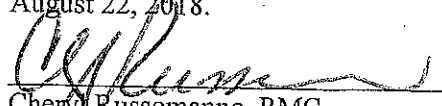
WHEREAS, the Municipal Council seeks to provide its advice and consent to the aforesaid re-appointment of Maureen Ruane, in accordance with *N.J.S.A. 40:69A-43(b)*; and

WHEREAS, Maureen Ruane shall be appointed as Business Administrator for a term that will expire upon appointment of a successor, at compensation provided for by the salary ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Council of the Township of Edison, Middlesex County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Municipal Council hereby provides its consent to the Mayor's re-appointment of Maureen Ruane to serve as Business Administrator, as well as its waiver of the residency requirement, for a term that will expire upon appointment of a successor, at compensation provided for by the salary ordinance.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be available for public inspection at the offices of the Township Clerk.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
