On March 10, 2023 at 0028 hours, I (Ptl. Martins) entered the parking lot of Quick Chek (3101 Bordentown Ave) when I was flagged down by a female, later identified as Desirae Lowe. Ms. Lowe approached this officer's patrol vehicle and stated that she needed help. Dispatch was advised of the unknown problem, at which time Ptl. Braun, Ptl. Raub, and Ptl. Lenahan advised that they would be responding.

Upon further speaking with Ms. Lowe, she advised that she had left a bar (Big Shots) with her friend in an Uber. While in the Uber, Ms. Lowe stated that she realized that she forgot her cellphone at the bar and requested the Uber driver to turn around. The Uber driver declined, at which time she requested to be let out of the Uber and ultimately ended up at Quick Chek. While attempting to assist Ms. Lowe, it was apparent that she was intoxicated. This officer could detect a heavy odor of alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath, and at times would trip over a curb and a shelf inside of the store. Ms. Lowe on scene also stated out loud that she was intoxicated. While on scene this officer requested an ambulance due to Ms. Lowe's high level of intoxication.

Upon speaking with Ms. Lowe officers attempted to contact the bar where her cell phone was allegedly left, but they advised that they did not have Ms. Lowe's phone. Ms. Lowe also did not know of any friends or family members phone numbers, so no one was able to be contacted. Ms. Lowe requested a transport to her residence in Toms River, but she was advised that we could not transport her there. While on scene speaking with Ms. Lowe, she would enter and exit the store numerous times, while screaming and yelling causing a disturbance. Ms. Lowe's actions on scene also kept members of the public from entering the store. Ms. Lowe was advised that she would be placed under arrest for disorderly conduct at this time. Dispatch was advised of the arrest and to also have EMS respond to headquarters, where they waited outside.

Ms. Lowe was handcuffed behind her back, which were checked for proper fit and double locked. Ms. Lowe was searched incident to arrest by Ptl. Braun for any weapons/contraband, which yielded negative results. Ms. Lowe was then placed in Ptl. Lenahan's patrol vehicle and was transported to police headquarters to begin the booking process, while this officer followed. Prior to placing Ms. Lowe in the patrol vehicle, she was advised that she would be audio and video recorded. The rear compartment was also checked for any weapons/contraband prior to placing Ms. Lowe in the patrol vehicle, which yielded negative results.

Once at police headquarters, officers secured our duty weapons in the sally port gun lockers and escorted Ms. Lowe to the booking room. Ptl. Lenahan, Ptl. Braun, and Ptl. Raub began the booking process, while this officer signed complaints against Ms. Lowe. While in the booking room, Ms. Lowe was uncooperative and would not allow for the booking photographs to be taken. Ms. Lowe would flail her arms and body and would also sit on the booking room floor. Ultimately Ms. Lowe was also charged with obstruction. While in the booking room Ms. Lowe hit her head against the booking room stool numerous times and needed to be restrained with a second pair of handcuffs to avoid further injury to herself.

While in the booking room, Ms. Lowe made statements to officers to shoot her and statements about self harm. Due to the statement and her actions of self-harm, it was determined that Ms. Lowe would be transported to Perth Amboy Hospital for crisis. EMS entered headquarters at this time to transport Ms. Lowe to the hospital. Ms. Lowe walked herself to the stretcher and laid down but began to flail her body and attempt to stand up. Officers on scene utilized compliance holds on Ms. Lowe, specifically by holding down her legs/arms so that handcuffs could be placed on her, and flexible handcuffs were utilized to secure her legs to the stretcher. Ptl. Braun and Ptl. Raub rode in the ambulance with Ms. Lowe while Ptl. Lenahan followed. Ms. Lowe was ultimately turned over to hospital staff without incident. Ms. Lowe's charges, 2C:33-2A and 2C:29-1A were placed on a Summons (1219 S 2023 000143) which will be mailed to her. This officer also mailed Ms. Lowe an

ordinance violation (1219 S23 2023 000001) for public intoxication. See Ptl. Raub, Ptl. Braun, and Ptl. Lenahan's supplemental reports for further information. This officer also completed a Use of Force form, due to utilizing a compliance hold on Ms. Lowe, specifically by holding down her legs. This officer also completed and submitted a Woodbridge Department of Mental Health and Human Services Form. Nothing further at this time.

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Officer Report Narrative

On Saturday 03/11/2023, I (Ptl. Raub) was on patrol in uniform in marked car #12. At approximately 0028 hours, I heard Ptl. Martins put over the radio that he was out at 3101 Bordentown Avenue (Quick Chek) with an unknown issue. Ptl. Braun, Ptl. Lenahan and I then responded to his location.

Upon arrival, I observed Ptl. Martins inside of the store talking to a female who was crying and visibly intoxicated. Ptl. Braun and I then entered the store and met with Ptl. Martins and a female, who was later identified as Desirea Lowe. Ptl. Martins advised that Desirea had lost her phone at a bar she only knew as "Big Shots" and that she took an Uber here and was trying to get back to the bar. At this time, we attempted to talk to Desirea to better understand what happened and how we could help her. During this time, Desirea was yelling and screaming at us and moving throughout the store. Desirea was pacing around the store drawing the attention of all of the store patrons and employees. All Officers on scene tried to talk to Desirea but she just continued to ramble and scream at us. Desirea advised us that she was with her friend "Christina Martinez", but she did not know where Christina went. Ptl. Braun contacted Big Shots Bar in Woodbridge and asked them if anyone turned in a cell phone and they stated no. Due to Desirea's erratic behavior and to not further disrupt

the business, we requested that she come outside and speak with us.

Once outside, Desirea began to walk around the building while continuing to yell and create a disturbance. We asked Desirea where she lived to that we could arrange a way for her to get home and stated that she lived in Toms River. A look up of Desirea's license showed that her address was

I then returned to my patrol car in an attempt to look up her address and find someone to come pick her up. A look up of the address did not show anyone with the same last name and her and she stated that she hasn't lived there in a while. While the other Officers were speaking to Desirea she continued to pace around and walked behind the building. We asked Desirea several time if she had any family nearby or if there was anywhere that we could bring her, and she just continues to act hysterical stating that it doesn't matter, and she doesn't care. Desirea then entered the store's vestibule and Ptl. Martins followed behind. While inside of the vestibule, Desirea continued to scream at Ptl. Martins and create a disturbance. At this time, I observed that there were customers that were hesitant to enter the store due to Desirea's erratic behavior.

At this time, I entered the vestibule, placed handcuffs on Desirea and advised her that she was under arrest for Disorderly Conduct. Desirea was handcuffed behind her back and the handcuffs were checked for proper fit and double locked. Desirea was then escorted to the front of car #3 and searched incident to arrest by Ptl. Braun in clear view of the MVR. Desirea was then placed in the rear prisoner compartment of car #3 and transported to Sayreville Police Headquarters by Ptl. Lenahan with Ptl. Martins, Ptl. Braun and I following behind. (See Ptl. Lenahan's supplemental report for further information about the transport.) Sayreville EMS was requested to meet us at headquarters.

Upon arrival, Desirea was escorted to the booking room where she was again searched by Ptl. Braun and secured to the stool in the booking room. During the booking process, Desirea continued with her belligerent and uncooperative behavior and refused to be booked. A short time later, Desirea sat on the floor in front of the booking stool and began to slam her forehead into the metal stool. At this time, Ptl. Braun, Ptl. Lenahan and I grabbed onto Desirea to prevent her from harming herself. We attempted to put a second handcuff on Desirea's left arm so that we could secure both of her arms, but she clenched it into her check. Ptl. Lenahan and I pulled her arm away from her body and placed it in the handcuff and then secured the handcuff to the hook in the wall. While doing this, Desirea yelled at us several times to shoot her and that she was done. Due to her attempt to self-harm and asking us to shoot her, it was determined that Desirea was going to be transported to Hackensack Meridian Health Center for a crisis evaluation.

Desirea was uncuffed from the booking stool and wall hook and escorted to stretcher. We attempted to only leave one set of handcuffs on her left arm to secure her to the stretcher, but she quickly resumed her erratic behavior forcing us to utilize two sets for the safety of all involved parties. With both hands/arms secured to the stretcher, Desirea then attempted to stand up on the stretcher. We guided her back down onto her butt and she began to kick her foot and pull out of the safety belts. Ptl. Lenahan and I then secured Desirea's legs with a pair of plastic zip handcuffs, but she continued to kick her legs. I then placed a handcuff over the zip handcuffs and one to the stretcher to secure her legs. Desirea was then escorted to the ambulance and loaded inside. Ptl. Braun and I rode inside of the ambulance with Desirea on the way to the hospital. During the transport, Desirea continued to yell and scream at Officers and EMS personnel. Desirea's mother was contacted by EMS personnel, and I advised her that Desirea was being transported to the hospital.

Upon arrival at the hospital, we met with the hospital security staff and escorted Desirea inside. Desirea was ultimately uncuffed and turned over to the hospital staff. Ptl. Martins completed criminal complaints against Desirea and placed them in the mail (Please see Ptl. Martins initial report for further information) After clearing from the hospital, I returned to Sayreville Police Headquarters where I completed and submitted a Benchmark Use of Force Report. Please see all other supplemental reports for further information.

Nothing further at this time.

On March 11, 2023 Ptl.Raub, Ptl.Lenahan and I, Ptl.Braun responded to Quick Chek (3101 Bordentown Avenue) to assist Ptl.Martins with an unknown issue. Ptl.Martins advised he was being flagged down by a citizen looking for assistance. Upon arrival, I entered the Quick Check and observed a female, later identified as Desirae Lowe, pacing the store acting erratic. Desirae paced from one corner of the store to the other, screaming to leave her alone and she is a grown adult. Ptl.Martins approached me and advised a citizen flagged him down to help Desirae who apparently left her phone at Big Shots Bar and had no cellphone or wallet. Desirae seemed to be confrontational with Ptl.Martins, so I attempted to speak with her. Desirae became confrontational with me and would not listen to me when I asked basic questions in an attempt to understand what the problem was and try and help. Desirae continued to yell at officers in the store and would have emotional outbursts. Eventually, we were able to understand that Desirae was in an Uber at some point in the evening with her friend. Desirae explained they were kicked out of the bar and took an Uber home. Desirae did not know where her friend Christina was, but figured Christina stayed in the Uber and went home. When officers asked Desirae where she lived (in an attempt to find a way to get her home) Desirae became further agitated and stated

she would walk home and was just fine. It should be noted Desirae had no idea she was in Sayreville and home (later determined was in Toms River) was approximately 50 minutes away. When we informed Desirae of this, she began crying. Desirae continued to act erratic despite all officers asking questions to try and help. Desirae ran into the bathroom at one point during the interaction and then proceeded to rush out of the store to get fresh air because she suffered from anxiety. Desirae's behavior became distracting for employees on scene and began affecting customers who were now afraid to enter the store. At this time, Ptl.Raub and Ptl.Lenahan placed Desirae under arrest for disorderly conduct. Refer to Ptl.Raub and Ptl.Lenahan's supplement report for further.

Desirae was escorted to the front of patrol vehicle #3 where I conducted a search incident to arrest. That search incident to arrest yielded negative weapons/contraband. Ptl.Lenahan escorted Desirae to the rear seat in vehicle #3. Desirae was advised she would be audio and visually recorded. The rear compartment was checked for weapons/contraband prior to Desirae being put in the rear seat. Desirae was transported back to headquarters to begin the arrest processing procedure.

Upon arrival to headquarters, Desirae was escorted into the booking room. Prior to entering the booking area, I secured my duty weapon in the gun locker in the hallway. I conducted a secondary search incident to arrest which again, yielded negative weapons or contraband. Desirae sat on the designated chair in the booking room where I secured her right arm in the handcuffs. Throughout this entire booking process, Desirae continued to act erratic and emotional. Desirae initially refused to be photographed, but eventually cooperated long enough to stand still for photos. At one point, Desirae sat on the floor of the booking room with her back towards officers. Desirae had her arms crossed against her chest and began slamming her head into the chair violently. Ptl.Lenahan, Ptl.Raub, Ptl.Martins and I all grabbed Desirae in an attempt to stop her from further inflicting harm to herself. Refer to the A.G. Use of Force reports for further.

Desirae was handcuffed and positioned where she could no longer be a threat to herself and attempt to smack her head on the chair again. Desirae became verbally aggressive towards officers and yelled "shoot me".

Sayreville EMS arrived on scene at this time. Desirae walked to the stretcher and was handcuffed to the stretcher. When Desirae realized the handcuffs were not coming off, she attempted to stand up right on the stretcher. Sgt.Szkodny came to the booking area with flex cuffs, which were secured to her legs to keep her from standing on the stretcher or flailing her legs.

On 3/11/2023 at 0028 hrs. I, Ptl. Lenahan self-dispatched myself to 3101 Bordentown Ave (QuickChek) to assist Ptl. Martins. Upon arrival, I was met by Desirae Lowe who was actively walking around the store acting belligerent and yelling at Ptl. Martins. Desirae stated that she was in an Uber and left Big Shots Bar in Woodbridge and was just trying to get home. Desirae stated that she got out of the Uber, which then left the scene. We attempted multiple times to figure out where Desirae lived, she stated that she lived in Manchester. Desirae did not have any property (i.e wallet, phone or identification) on her. Desirae then walked out of the store, stating that she needed to get some air, may it be noted that she was still acting belligerent and yelling at us.

We attempted several more times to obtain any type of information that would help us get Desirae to somewhere to stay the night. She again stated that she just wanted to go home and started to cry. Desirae then attempted to go back inside the store and stopped in the vestibule and continued to yell at Ptl. Martins. She kept making a scene, and at this point was preventing patrons of the store to enter. Desirae was then advised that she was being placed under arrest for disorderly conduct. Desirae was placed in handcuffs, the handcuffs were tested for fit and double locked. Desirae was searched incident to arrest in front of marked vehicle #3, by Ptl. Braun. Desirae was escorted to the

rear of car #3 and advised of being recorded audibly and visually. The rear of the vehicle was checked prior to placing Desirae inside. I transported Desirae to headquarters in car #3 as Ptl. Martins followed. During the transport Desirae continued to act belligerent, she was crying and screaming that she wanted her mom. Desirae slammed her head against the partition during the transport. Prior to leaving the scene dispatch was advised to start EMS to headquarters.

Upon arrival to police headquarters, we secured our duty weapons in the salle-port gun lockers. Desirae was then escorted to the booking room where she was searched again, by Ptl. Braun before being handcuffed to the booking room stool. Desirae refused to comply with the booking process as she continued to act belligerent. While asking her the booking questions she refused to answer and refused to take the booking photos. Desirae was sitting on the floor next to the booking room stool at which point she stated that she "wanted to die" to "just shoot her" and started to slam her head into the booking room stool. At which point we restrained her and placed her in a second set of handcuffs, securing her to the wall. During the handcuff process Desirae was grabbing the bottom of the booking room stool in an attempt to not allow us to handcuff her. I assisted Ptl. Raub by grabbing her left wrist and removed it from the stool, to attempt to place her in a second set of cuffs.

Sayreville EMS arrived to take Desirae to the hospital for intoxication, at which point we uncuffed Desirae and escorted her to the stretcher. Desirae was not compliant, so we handcuffed both of Desirae's hands to the stretcher. Desirae attempted to stand up on the stretcher, we then placed Desirae's feet in flex cuffs and handcuffed the flex cuffs to the stretcher. Sayreville EMS then transported her to Perth Amboy Hospital for crisis as well as intoxication, as I followed in car #3. A bench mark use of force was completed and submitted. See Ptl. Martins initial report for further information. No further police action taken. End of report.
