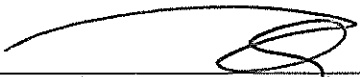
IT IS therefore agreed that St. Joseph's Family Medicine will:

1. Conduct pre-participation physicals for athletics, band and ROTC students for grades 6-12.
2. The cost of each physical will be \$30.00 per student to an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00. Maximum of 500 physicals.
3. St. Joseph's Family Medicine shall be paid when an invoice is submitted after the completion of the physicals.
4. The contract shall be in effect from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022.

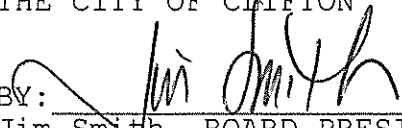

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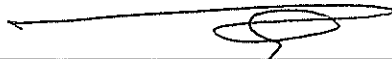
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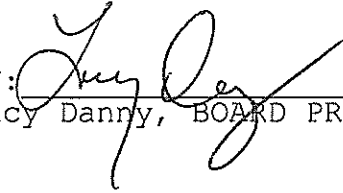

WHEREAS, medical services are provided to the Board of Education to meet district needs; and

WHEREAS, the medical services providers are periodically reviewed and requests for submission of proposals for contracted services are solicited; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Clifton is desirous of contracting with New Jersey Orthopaedic Institute located at 504 Valley Road, Wayne, NJ to provide services as the District Athletic Team Physician,

IT IS therefore agreed as follows:

1. New Jersey Orthopaedic Institute (Dr. Vincent McInerney) shall be paid \$5,000.00 per annum for review of pre-participation physicals of all athletics, band and ROTC students grades 6-12 on a schedule of \$1000.00 per month for 5 months (July through November).
2. New Jersey Orthopaedic Institute will also be paid \$200.00 per game for attendance at all home varsity football games (not to exceed 25) which shall be paid after each game upon receipt of invoice.
3. This Contract will be in effect from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

In the event that New Jersey Orthopaedic Institute is unable to deliver the above cited services, this contract shall be considered null and void. In addition both parties agree that this Contract may be terminated upon 15 days written notice by either party.

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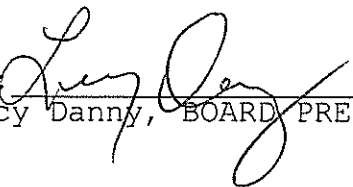

AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, medical services are provided by the Board of Education to meet district needs, and

WHEREAS, the medical services providers are periodically reviewed and requests for submission of proposals for contracted services is solicited, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Clifton is desirous of contracting with Immedicenter (Dr. Michael Basista) located at 1355 Broad Street, Clifton, NJ to provide services as the District Chief School Medical Inspector,

IT IS therefore agreed that the Immedicenter will perform the following duties:

1. Consult in the development and implementation of school district policies, procedures, and mechanisms related to health, safety and medical emergencies pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:16-2.1(a);
2. Consult with the school district's medical staff regarding the delivery of school health services, which includes special health care needs of technology supported and medically fragile children, including those covered by 20 U.S.C. §§ 1400 et seq, Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act;
3. Consult with the district Board of Education, school district administrators and staff as needed;
4. Conduct physical examinations in the school physician's office for students who do not have a medical home or whose parent has identified the school as a medical home;
5. Provide written standing orders that shall be reviewed and reissued before the beginning of each school year;
6. Establish standards of care for emergency situations and medically related care involving students and school staff;
7. Review, as requested, of reports and orders from a student's medical home regarding student health concerns;

8. Review, approve or provide detail reasons for denial of a student's physician's determination of anticipated confinement and resulting home instruction;

9. Consult with the district certified nurse(s) to obtain input for the development of the school Nursing Services Plan, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:16-2.1;

10. Conduct pre-employment examination of all potential employees of the district and examination of transportation personnel as required.

11. The Immedicenter shall be paid \$2373.33 per month for 12 months as full compensation for these services.

12. The contract shall be in effect from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

In the event that Immedicenter is unable to deliver the above cited services, this contract shall be considered null and void. In addition both parties agree that this Contract may be terminated upon 15 days written notice by either party.
