Affidavit of Probable Cause

On August 18, 2020, at approximately 1:35 pm, personnel with the Asbury Park Police Department ("APPD") responded to 1100 Boston Way, Apartment 902, for reported gunfire. The Asbury Park ShotSpotter system also indicated that there were approximately five shots fired in the area. ShotSpotter is an acoustic sensing system capable of identifying, discriminating, and reporting gunshot information to the police in less than sixty seconds of a shot being fired. The APPD fielded additional phone calls reporting the shooting. Neighbors reported to the police that there was a shooting with a gunshot victim from apartment 902. Members of the APPD immediately began looking at surveillance cameras in the area.

Video surveillance showed a black male, riding a black cruiser type bicycle, wearing black athletic pants with white vertical stripes on the sides, a white t-shirt with a stripe on the shoulder, black sneakers and white socks. The male was observed riding south on Sylvan Avenue towards the area of where the shooting occurred, having turned onto Sylvan Avenue from Springwood Avenue. The male then proceeded south on Sylvan Avenue and stopped and spoke with a subject identified as Witness 1, a lighter skinned male. The two spoke for a short period of time before the male on the bicycle continued to travel south on Sylvan Avenue until he reached the intersection of Boston Way / Sylvan Avenue. From the video, a silver colored revolver can be clearly observed in the male's right hand. The male then set the bike down in the street, raised his right arm and fired the weapon towards 1100 Boston Way, apartment 902. Several people can be observed on or near the porch of apartment 902 – two black males, two black females, a 12 year-old black female, and a 4 year-old black female. From the video, it appears as the shooter was firing at one or both of the black males on or near the porch. One of the black males on the porch of 902 is then observed firing a gun back in the direction of the black male on the bicycle. The male on the bicycle then ran on foot in the direction of Heck Avenue.

As a result of the gunfire, the four (4) year old female victim was struck in the left leg with a bullet strike. She was transported to Jersey Shore University Medical Center (JSUMC) in her mother's car prior to the arrival of APPD. It was learned through medical personnel that the 4 year-old victim suffered a through and through gunshot wound to her left leg causing a broken left femur. She was taken into surgery to have the wound cleaned and then admitted to the Intensive Care Unit.

On the evening of August 18, 2020, Detective Dillon Gourley of the Asbury Park Police Department and Detective William Anton of the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office Major Crime Bureau spoke with the Witness 2, who was present at the time of the shooting and located in close proximity to the 4 year-old victim. Witness 2 identified the person on the bicycle as "Mucc". Detectives identified Sciaire Jackson ("Jackson") as a black male with the nickname "Mucc or Mucca." Jackson also matched the description of the black male on the bicycle. A photograph of Jackson was located in the Spillman database which also contained his nickname as being "Mucca."

Members of the investigative team learned that on prior to the shooting, at approximately 9:53 am on August 18, 2020, officers with the Neptune Township Police Department conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Neptune Blvd. and West Bangs Avenue. During that stop, a red Buick bearing NJ registration [REDACTED] was stopped as the vehicle was observed bearing front window tint. The operator of the vehicle was identified as Jackson. The NTPD officers conducting the motor vehicle stop observed that Jackson was wearing a white shirt with horizontal stripes on the shoulders and blue pants with white vertical stripes on both legs. The officers also observed

Jackson to have two (2) tattoos on his face and a tattoo on his forearm. The motor vehicle stop was captured on MVR. One of the officers who conducted the stop later observed a photograph depicting the suspected shooter and advised that the subject observed in the photograph was wearing the exact clothing as the clothing that Jackson was wearing at the time of the traffic stop.

On August 19, 2020, members of the investigative team again met with the Witness 2, who previously identified the shooter on the bicycle as being "Mucc." Witness 2 agreed to be interviewed and participate in a photo array in furtherance of this investigation. As a result, a photo array was prepared and conducted by a detective who had no prior knowledge of this case. During the photo display procedure, Witness 2 identified Jackson AKA: "Mucc" as being the subject on the bicycle who fired the shots during the shooting on August 18, 2020 which resulted in the four year-old victim being shot. Witness 2 reported knowing Jackson. Witness 2 was questioned about the second person involved in the incident who fired the gun back at Jackson; Witness 2 reportedly did not see anyone on the porch firing a gun due to running inside immediately after hearing the shots. Both the photo display procedure and the interview were recorded on video. It should be noted that at the conclusion of the interview and off camera, Witness 2 was asked if s/he knew "Mucc's" brother. Witness 2 replied by stating that his name was "60." Members of the investigative team confirmed that "60" is the street name utilized by Jackson's brother, Sci'mel Jackson.

On August 19, 2020, members of the investigative team traveled to Jackson's girlfriend's residence in Shrewsbury Township. Upon arrival, Jackson was located, taken into custody and transported to the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office – Asbury Park Satellite Office without incident.

Upon arrival at the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office, Jackson was escorted into an audio and video recorded interview room. Jackson waived Miranda and agreed to speak with detectives. Jackson confirmed that on August 18, 2020, he was in Asbury Park, NJ riding a bicycle in the area of the Boston Way housing complex. Jackson reported that when he arrived at the intersection of Sylvan Avenue / Boston Way, he heard gunshots. Jackson explained that when he heard the gunshots, he dropped the bicycle in the roadway and ran before calling for a ride. Jackson confirmed that prior to the shooting, he saw and talked to Witness 1 on the street.

Jackson described the bicycle that he was riding as being black in color and explained that he obtained it from a subject in the Asbury Park Village apartment complex. Jackson reported that at the time of the incident, he was wearing the same outfit that he was wearing at the time of the interview, referring to athletic pants and a white shirt. Jackson advised that the shirt that he was wearing during the time of the shooting was different than the shirt he was wearing during the interview as it had a "design" on it. Jackson also confirmed that prior to the shooting, he was driving his mother's vehicle and was pulled over on Bangs Avenue by the Neptune Police Department for having tinted windows.

Jackson advised that after he left the area of Boston Way he ultimately arrived at his girlfriend's residence located in Shrewsbury Township, NJ where he spent the night. His whereabouts immediately following the shooting before he arrived at his girlfriend's residence are unknown. Jackson reported that earlier on August 19, he traveled to his mother's residence located in Lakewood, NJ, before returning back to his girlfriend's home.

Jackson was shown still images depicted from area surveillance cameras at the time of the shooting incident and confirmed that the subject riding the bicycle was him. When asked about the handgun observed in his hand, Jackson denied possessing a weapon and denied engaging in the shooting. Jackson reported being referred to by multiple street names including but not limited to "Groove," "Mucca" and "Mucc."

A review of Jackson's criminal history revealed that he was convicted of Distribution of CDS within 1000 feet of school property on September 29, 2017.
