The Town of Secaucus received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on January 29, 2025. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is February 7, 2025. Please accept this letter in response to your request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

If records were denied in their entirety, give a general nature description of the record.	List the legal explanation and statutory citation for the denial of access to records in their <u>entirety</u> or <u>with redactions</u> .
“Under OPRA/FOIA/Public Records laws, I am requesting the following documents: Body Camera footage of the incident in Case Number 24-032037 Date of Incident: 07/08/2024 Location: 249 Route 3 East, Secaucus, NJ 07094”	This incident pertains to arrest of juveniles, due to this arrest, records are safeguarded from public inspection. Juvenile records are exempt from disclosure under 2A:4A-60.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Secaucus to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at

www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
