Dear Ciaran Johnson,

The Town of Secaucus received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on April 4, 2025. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is April 14, 2025. Please accept this letter in response to your request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

“Arrest reports including officer narrative that have been coded as resisting arrest from 10/01/2024 to 10/14/2024.”

Please see attached all the arrest during the requested time of period, redactions have been made to protect confidential personal identifying information pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1. We are not including arrests for domestic violence incidents and juvenile offenders which are exempt from release. Narratives are included on the reports and we are not required to perform a search for specific arrest reports pertaining to specific charges, so all reports are being provided for you sort through for what you are looking for. These records are being transmitted to you via email, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.00.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Secaucus to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
