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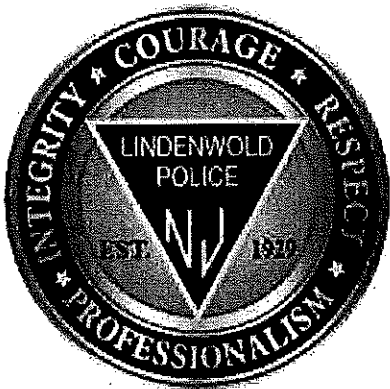

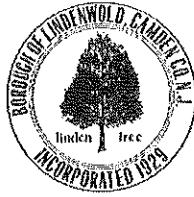

1. The above named party, does hereby agree to rent the Lindenwold Community Center on _____ 20 _____ for use between the hours of _____ and _____, for a total of _____ hours. The rental fee is \$ _____ and must be paid in full with the application.

2. A security deposit of \$100.00 is required upon approval of this application.

TWO CHECKS -- ONE FOR THE RENTAL FEE AND ONE FOR THE SECURITY DEPOSIT.

- A. This deposit will be used to cover the cost of any damage to the hall or cleanup of the premises.
 - B. Cleanup includes the removal of trash to trash bins, removal of decorations, mopping of spills and floor swept. Reset tables and chairs as you found them. Turn off the lights. Decorations may only be attached by use of thumb tacks in a non-marring location and/or masking tape.
 - C. If the damages exceed the amount of the deposit, the user shall be liable and billed for the actual amount of the damages, minus the deposit. The user agrees to pay said amount.
 - D. The Borough will return to the user the security deposit less charges and a statement itemizing any deductions.
 - E. In the event that any renter is responsible for any false alarms to the Fire Department or the Police Department said renter shall forfeit \$50.00 of the security deposit.
3. The rental of the hall shall include use of the kitchen. The area must be cleaned thoroughly and any remaining food or supplies removed.
4. Alcoholic beverages and controlled and/or dangerous substances are prohibited from being consumed or brought into the building.
5. Smoking is strictly prohibited.

6. The Borough of Lindenwold shall assume no responsibility for any injuries and/or illness to anyone attending a function in the building or on the property. The applicant shall indemnify the Borough (hold it harmless) for any such injuries and/or illness arising out of the use of building by the user or guests.
7. The building shall not be used for promotional or political purposes. Restricted uses are yard sales, flea markets and dances.
8. The maximum capacity of the facility is 200 people.
9. Upon approval, the applicant may obtain the key to the building and security code from the Borough Clerk's office between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The key must be returned to the Clerk's Office on the next working day. Signatures will be required.
10. Please let the Borough Clerk know if you are not going to use the building.

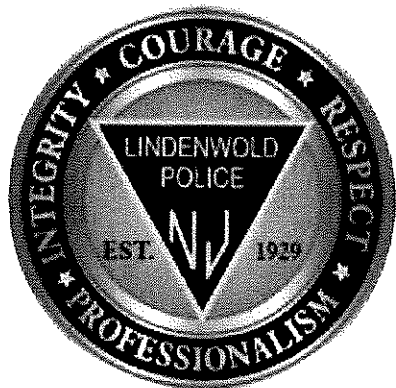

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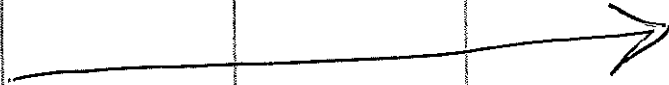

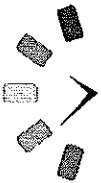
