

Chapter 69. Alcoholic Beverages

Article III. Open Containers in Public Places

§ 69-18. Open containers in public places prohibited.

[Amended 6-14-2000 by Ord. No. 1073]

No person shall have in his or her possession any open container containing an alcoholic beverage in any place generally open to or accessible by the general public, including but not limited to any roadway, parking lot, sidewalk, playground, park and/or public building, but specifically not including any premises licensed for the sale and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages or any commercial establishment which invites patrons to consume patron-provided alcoholic beverages.

Chapter 229. Peace and Good Order

Article II. Disorderly Conduct

§ 229-6. Public intoxication; use of drugs.

No person shall be intoxicated or under the influence of drug or drugs or a barbiturate in any street, highway, thoroughfare or public place within the limits of the Borough or in any hotel, boardinghouse, store, restaurant or other quasi-public place to the annoyance of any person.

Chapter 269. Smoking and Vaping

Article I. Smoking and Vaping on Public Property

§ 269-2. Prohibited acts.

- A. No person shall engage in smoking or vaping on any property owned or controlled by the Borough of Lindenwold.
- B. No person shall engage in smoking or vaping in any public park, ball field, playground, courts, trails, or grounds, including sidewalks immediately adjacent to said property.
- C. No person shall engage in smoking or vaping on or in any public elementary school or school property, regardless of whether the area is an indoor public place or outdoor public place, including sidewalks immediately adjacent to said property.
- D. No person shall engage in smoking or vaping in any public building or facility in the Borough of Lindenwold.

Chapter 349. Vehicles, Motor-Driven

§ 349-1. Operation of certain vehicles on public property prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any type of unlicensed motor-driven vehicle or conveyance, including but not necessarily limited to snowmobiles, two-wheel motor vehicles known as "mini bicycles," "trail bicycles," and "motor scooters" and four-wheel motor vehicles commonly known as "go-carts" upon any public property or Borough-owned land in the Borough of Lindenwold, New Jersey.
