I have attached Directive #26-19. It specifically states how citizen complaints are supposed to be handled as of January 1, 2020. It states that only a judge is authorized to determine probable cause on a private citizen complaint charging an indictable offense. Your email below indicates that a Cumberland County Prosecutor was sworn in as a SDAG for the specific purpose of reviewing MY complaints. Could that Prosecutor be Ms. Lesley Snock that was sworn in by Emily Anderson from the Attorney General's Office the very same day that I filed those complaints on December 12, 2022?

Ms. Gilmore, I feel as if nobody is taking anything I file seriously. The charges that I filed are extremely significant and had numerous documents to prove what I alleged and they need to be handled appropriately, not disregarded by a prosecutor that got sworn in just to refuse my complaints. The courts were given the directive to follow by the Acting Administrative Director, Judge Glenn Grant on December 20, 2019 to follow, not ignore. The directive further states that I was to receive the outcome of any denial within 45 days. As of today I still have not received a denial. It's been 212 days.

Can someone please explain what exactly has gone on with my very legitimate complaints against these public officials? I have been extremely patient. At this point I really feel that my husband and I both have been mistreated by the judiciary in all counties that are involved in his cases.

As a former judiciary employee I have to say that I am more disappointed now than I was when I resigned from my position. I left the judiciary because of all their poor treatment to private citizens and constant cover ups of their actions. I could not be a party to that kind of behavior towards citizens being abused by the system.

I would appreciate documentation of requests for extensions of time regarding my complaints if your court has those. I also am aware that Christopher Koos was given access to these complaints. I would like to know his exact position and why he was personally so interested that he filed an unwarranted Judiciary Incident Report about me personally?

I hope to hear back from you this time with all the information that I have requested. Please realize that I am not trying to be difficult but my husband has been unjustly detained for nearly 8 months now and while in the Cumberland County Jail he found an antipsychotic medication in his food. My husband has NEVER been on medication like that. He was transferred to Hudson county jail and suffered a seizure that has never been neurologically followed up on. Never before has he had a seizure episode. He is basically at their mercy while they try to force a plea out of him. If this was your loved one how would you handle it?

My husband did not stalk these judges and he only tried to defend himself against their mishandling of his cases and proven misconduct. We have provided the proof in our complaints against these public officials. I urge you to realize that my husband is only one of many that is sitting in a jail cell pre trial and is innocent. Where is innocent until PROVEN guilty? Is this really America?

I am attempting to find out what has happened to the charges that I filed in December against the following individuals:

- 1) Judge Bernard DeLury

I haven't received any documentation about these charges and have no charge number for them. I'm told that I should have at least heard back from someone within 45 days yet nobody has even acknowledged my inquiries.

I have come to learn that an employee of the judiciary Christopher Koos has filed a Judiciary Incident Report about me for filing my complaints and has referred to me as a security issue as well as a Vexatious Litigant. Neither are true and as a citizen my rights were violated by his inappropriate and inaccurate report that is based off his own opinion without any factual basis and without ever having any kind of discussion with me about my charges.

The charges that I filed were filed with numerous documents to support my allegations. The fact that one of your court officials has now attempted to wrongly discredit me should send these complaints to another venue. Have my complaints been wrongfully removed without any notice to me?

I have copied my husband's attorney Kenneth Rosellini in this email since it is now my 4th attempt to find out what has happened to these charges. I had requested a Special Prosecutor due to the nature of the charges and the fact that the charges are against public officials.

I would like to know how, as a witness to these crimes, I can secure some protection from the retaliation? These Judges enlisted judicial employees and the state police to wrongly surveillance my social media accounts as well as my husband's to use our freedom of speech to attempt to make us out to be threats to the judiciary.

We have a right to expose the judiciary misconduct, abuse of power tactics and any other improper activities they conduct as public officials without retaliation. Sheriff's Officers showing up at my house with large guns and shields with bench warrants for missed court dates certainly appears to be retaliation.

The court has not treated my husband fairly nor have they followed proper court procedures. Between Ocean County, Monmouth County, Atlantic County and now Cumberland County. It would appear that they are all just covering for one another's misconduct and then continue the abuse of power by denying simple Constitutional Rights.

For years we have been attempting to resolve my husband's cases. Then we find out the courts took his cases apart from their intended disposition without any notice to my husband. Where are his due process rights?

As a witness to all of these crimes unto my husband and now his liberties being completely stripped by trumped up allegations, I want protection from the continued judicial abuse of power by staff members.

Please respond by telling me what is going on with these charges? If another judiciary incident report is filed with my name in it, I wish to be copied immediately. I consider these complaints to be harassment and intimidation as I am a witness. I wish to seek protection and a victim/witness advocate.

I am copying several people in this email, including the US attorney for the district of New Jersey, Mr. Phillips Sillinger. I'm contacting you directly as you are mentioned by State Law Enforcement involved in this matter.

Attached is my correspondence with the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office this morning. I think it is important for everyone included in this email to understand everything that has gone on within the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office as it relates to the defendant, Jason Samaritano, who is also my husband.

As you may or may not know, my husband filed a lawsuit against some Ocean County Court personnel many years ago, in 2016. Because of that lawsuit we have had a conflict with the Ocean County Vicinage. Attached is a letter from former Ocean County Assignment Judge Marlene Lynch Ford outlining the conflict of interest.

Since then my husband has been the target of retaliation by the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office. I am forwarding the email I sent to the AG's office along with Ms. Snock's OPRA requested emails that I am deeply concerned about. Even Ms. Gallagher is included in these emails and she rightfully questions the actions of the Atlantic County prosecutors for filing a motion for detention in a conflicted vicinage.

My husband has been detained over 10 months now and extremely unfairly treated. Its clear that the Atlantic and Cumberland vicinages are closely aligned and even share judges. However, that causes a conflict of interest for these cases to be heard in the Cumberland County Vicinage.

The fact that the vicinage is an extreme burden on our family to travel to and from in order to attend these hearings means that it never should have been there from the start. Cumberland County is not a venue that should have even been a consideration when determining where these cases would go. The fact that Ms. Snock and Jeffrey Barile from the AG'S office are friends makes this choice even more suspicious.

The emails that I obtained clearly show Ms. Snock conspiring with both Ocean and Atlantic vicinages in order to hold my husband as long as possible. He was never before a judge within 48 hours as required. That violates his Constitutional Rights, state statutes and the rules of criminal procedures regarding bail reform.

Furthermore, Cumberland is 2 hours for my family to travel to be there for Jason for court and if we can visit it is close to impossible. He was unable to object to this venue change because he did not have legal counsel when the venue change took place.

I need my husband released. He has health issues and where he is being detained in the Cumberland County jail has proven to be a danger to him and a complete violation of his rights as a defendant to have his trial closer to his residence. Please get back to me ASAP as this situation is time sensitive since my husband has developed a large mass under his chin. Please help us. My husband has been locked up for over 10 months for a crime he did not commit. See the attached. Thank you for your time.

He was never before a judge within 48 hours as required. That violates his Constitutional Rights, state statutes and the rules of criminal procedures regarding bail reform.

I have been pleading with you to release my husband and to please consider the facts behind his arrest. This is not a judge stalking and/or harassment case. This is a citizen that has been wronged by the justice system for many years. I know because I have been forced to live it with him along with the rest of our family.

The over 10 months that he has been wrongfully detained he has missed his children's prom, high school graduation, a child's surgery, and now has developed medical issues of his own that need tending to. I am quite sure at this juncture that Jason has been punished enough for something that was nothing more than poor judgment that stemmed from years of built up frustration with how his cases have been mishandled.

My husband sat in the Ocean County Jail for 5 months in 2020. A jail in a vicinage that was a complete conflict. That's a total of over 15 months of our lives that we cannot get back. Our children cannot get that time back with their father that they deeply depend upon for his love and support.

Please consider the issues that I have addressed here. Cumberland County is not the proper venue and it has no legal jurisdiction from everything I have read regarding where venue must be laid. My husband had no legal counsel to object to the venue transfer on his behalf. In fact when he was assigned legal counsel through Cumberland County, he was given Ms. Snock's Facebook friend, Alexander Varghese. An appearance of impropriety is strongly suggested in that

assignment and from these emails it appears no assignment was made until on or about December 12th. At least 6 days after his arrest.

Good evening. I was able to locate more information involving the Cumberland County Assistant Prosecutor assigned to my husband, Jason Samaritano's cases. It is my FIRM belief that Cumberland County is NOT the proper venue for these cases based on Assistant Prosecutor Lesley Snock's unethical behavior and her connections with Deputy Attorney General Jeffrey Barile. Upon reviewing her Facebook page I was able to discover that she is friends with Mr. Barile. I further discovered that she is friends with the public defender that originally represented my husband, Alex Varghese. Mr. Varghese refused to share information with me and never disclosed to my husband anything about his pre-indictment conference that was originally supposed to be before Judge Zeigler.

She emails Assistant Attorney General Emily Anderson about that on Dec 5th and 6th. From the remaining email it is evident that the two had spoken over the phone or that there are some emails missing. It has never been proven that Mr. Barile Swore her in and Ms. Anderson ended up swearing her in on December 12th. Had she truly been sworn in on Dec 2nd as she indicated in her emails then Ms. Anderson would not have had to do that again.

Furthermore, Cumberland is 2 hours for my family to travel to be there for Jason for court and if we can visit it is close to impossible. He was unable to object to this venue change because he did not have legal counsel when the venue change took place.

I need my husband released. He has health issues and where he is being detained in the Cumberland County jail has proven to be a danger to him and a complete violation of his rights as a defendant to have his trial closer to his residence. Please get back to me ASAP as this situation is time sensitive since my husband has developed a large mass under his chin. Please help us. My husband has been locked up for over 10 months for a crime he did not commit. See the attached. Thank you for your time.
