The Township of Clark received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on January 8, 2024. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is January 17, 2024. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 3rd business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

1. Settlement Agreement or Release that resolved Idelfonso Colon v. Patrol Officer Christopher Tuccio, et al, Docket No. UNN-L-582-22:

There exists no retrievable record in regard to a Settlement Agreement or Release. The matter of Colon v. Tuccio, et al. Docket No. UNN-L-582-22 was stayed by the Honorable John Hudak on December 2, 2022.

The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
