Narrative
 On Tuesday, 11/12/2019, I (Ofc. S. Mateo #263) was assigned to patrol, crash investigation, utilizing vehicle 216. At approximately 0209 hours dispatch relayed a message of a disorderly male, refusing to leave the establishment of Just Jake's, 30 Park Street. Officers B. Taylor, M. Kupchak, and C. Adams all responded to the scene.

Upon arrival, we were met by the caller and managers of the establishment, Mr. Wayne Zimmerman of 101 Newark Ave, Bloomfield, NJ, Mr. Marc Koeppel of 33 Montague Pl and Mr. Stephen Antonelli of 177 Liberty St Apt 43, Bloomfield, NJ. Mr. Zimmerman stated that a patron, later identified as Mr. Richard Webster of 133 Wildwood Avenue had refused to leave the establishment.

Mr. Zimmerman stated that he advised Mr. Webster numerous times that they were beyond the "last call" notice and he had to leave the premises. He also stated that Mr. Webster was heavily intoxicated and continually refused to leave, becoming more and more aggressive with them. They advised him that if he did not leave then they would contact this agency to remove him. Mr. Zimmerman stated that Mr. Webster continued to refuse to leave and began reaching into his pockets. Fearful for the safety of the employees present at that time and given the stature of Mr. Webster, Mr. Zimmerman contacted this agency.

As we attempted to speak with Mr. Webster he refused our requests to exit the establishment. He then began to continually place his hands in his pockets after being asked to remove them. At that time, for the safety of all individuals on scene, I attempted to terry frisk Mr. Webster to no avail. He tensed up his body and began to thrust his shoulders towards me. At this time I was still unable to frisk Mr. Webster without resistance. Mr. Webster stands approximately 6'4" and weighs approximately 250lbs. We grabbed Mr. Webster by his arms and escorted him outside of the establishment. As we reached the front of the establishment he became even more aggressive and began poking his fingers into the chest of officers. We attempted to secure him against the wall of the building for his own protection and officer safety, however he continued to physically resist our orders. We also verbally requested him to leave on his own accord to no avail as he physically resisted.

Mr. Webster was visibly intoxicated and was having difficulty standing and walking. Each time we walked towards the street from the establishment, Mr. Webster would attempt to resist us and remain on the premises. On two occasions, as Mr. Webster pushed towards us, he had lost balance and fell backwards. To prevent any further incidents from occurring, and given the numerous opportunities provided to Mr. Webster to comply with our requests, he was placed under arrest.

Mr. Webster was placed into the rear of vehicle 216 and transported to police headquarters for further processing. The rear of vehicle 216 was searched prior to and after the transport, yielding negative results for any contraband.

A record check was conducted, determining Mr. Webster to be negative for any outstanding warrants at that time. While at police headquarters Mr. Webster refused to comply with basic processing by refusing to take the required photos and was advised he would be charged with obstruction.
