If you do not file and serve a written answer or motion within 35 days, the court may enter a judgment against you for the relief plaintiff demands, plus interest and costs of suit. If judgment is entered against you, the Sheriff may seize your money, wages or property to pay all or part of the judgment.

If you cannot afford an attorney, you may call the Legal Services office in the county where you live. A list of these offices is provided. If you do not have an attorney and are not eligible for free legal assistance, you may obtain a referral to an attorney by calling one of the Lawyer Referral Services. A list of these numbers is also provided.

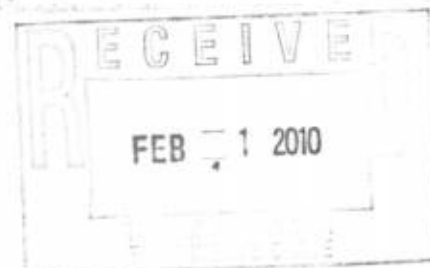

3. On or about April 7, 2008, at approximately 1:00 p.m., Plaintiff, Sandra Pasquariello, was lawfully walking on the sidewalk in front of Wachovia Bank, N.A. located at 10 Dehart Street in

4. The portion of sidewalk in front of 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, was raised and directly and/or indirectly contributed and/or caused Plaintiff, Sandra Pasquariello, to trip and fall thereby sustaining severe and permanent injuries.

5. Defendant, Town of Morristown, was reckless, careless and/or negligent in creating, maintaining and/or failing to warn of the dangerous and/or hazardous condition of the sidewalk in front of 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, was reckless, careless and/or negligent in failing to cordon off the dangerous and/or hazardous condition of the sidewalk in front of 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, and was reckless, careless and/or negligent in failing and/or refusing to inspect and/or repair the sidewalk in front of 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey.

6. Defendants, 10 Dehart Street, LLC, were reckless, careless and/or negligent in creating, maintaining and/or failing to warn of the dangerous and/or hazardous condition of the sidewalk located at 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, were reckless, careless and/or negligent in failing to cordon off the dangerous and/or hazardous condition of the sidewalk in front of 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, and were reckless, careless and/or negligent in failing and/or refusing to inspect and/or repair the sidewalk in front of 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey.

Defendant, Fiore Consulting, was reckless, careless and/or negligent in creating, maintaining and/or failing to warn of the dangerous and/or hazardous condition of the sidewalk in front of 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, was reckless, careless and/or negligent in failing to cordon off the dangerous and/or hazardous condition of the sidewalk in front of 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, and was reckless, careless and/or negligent in failing and/or refusing to inspect and/or repair the sidewalk in front of 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey.

2. On or about April 7, 2008, Plaintiff, Sandra Pasquariello, was lawfully on the premises owned, operated, managed, controlled, maintained, inspected and/or repaired by defendant, John Does Corps. (owners being fictitious as unknown) located at 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey.

3. Plaintiff, Sandra Pasquariello, was lawfully walking on the sidewalk located at 10 Dehart Street in the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey. The defendant, John Does Corps., negligently and/or carelessly operated, owned, supervised, constructed and/or maintained said area so as to cause plaintiff to trip and fall and become injured.

4. The sidewalk had uneven bricks which the defendant, John Does Corps. had carelessly and negligently permitted to stand and remain on the said area for a long period of time and beyond the time required for its discovery and/or removal.

5. Because of the uneven bricks, the area was dangerous and unsafe for use by the

plaintiff and other persons.

6. Defendant, John Does Corps. failed to maintain the walkway with due care rendering the said area dangerous and unsafe for use.

7.. Defendant, John Does Corps., failed to inform and warn plaintiff and other persons using the sidewalk of this dangerous and unsafe condition.

8. Defendant, John Does Corps. carelessly and negligently failed to properly inspect and maintain the sidewalk in a safe condition for use.

9. Defendant, John Does Corps., knew, or could, by the exercise of ordinary and reasonable care, have known, of the unsafe and dangerous conditions then and there existed in the said area.

10. As a direct and proximate result of the Defendant, John Does Corps.'s, negligence, carelessness, and recklessness, and improper conduct in maintaining the said premises, the Plaintiff, Sandra Pasquariello while on the said premises as aforesaid on the aforementioned date, was caused to trip and fall to the ground and suffered painful and permanent injuries in and about her body, was seriously injured, sustained great pain and suffering and mental anguish, does presently sustain the same and in the future will sustain the same, was obliged to expend large sums of money to affect a cure for the injuries, pain and suffering and mental anguish, which she sustained, and is presently obligated to expend large sums of money and in the future will be obligated to expend large sums of money so as to affect a cure for the injuries which she sustained.
