The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has completed a review of the Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund (HDSRF) funding request received November 14, 2025. The request was submitted for the remedial action activities that have been proposed at Egg Harbor City Landfill aka Antwerp Avenue Landfill (site), which is part of Egg Harbor City's Antwerp Avenue Brownfield Development Area (BDA).

Based on a review of the request, the Department has determined that it is technically eligible for HDSRF funding. Therefore, the Department recommends that the NJEDA obligate funds in the amount of **\$3,046,580** for the proposed RA work. The Department is not recommending a disbursement at this time.
