You sent your opra request via email on Sunday, September 3, 2023, which is not during normal business hours. The Custodian of Records received via email your request on Tuesday, September 5, 2023 which was the next business day. Therefore, the seven (7) business day deadline is Thursday, September 14, 2023.

Your OPRA request seeks access to the following:

I would like a copy of all deleted comments, page user's role page, profanity filter page and banned profile page for all social media accounts owned or controlled by Lavallette to include the police department from July 24, 2023 through September 6, 2023

I would like a copy of all emails to or from Barbara SIJSINNO to the council, the mayor and/or the EPA committee from January 1, 2020 through September, 6, 2023

I would like a copy of all payroll records or checks issued to Barbara Susinno from January 1, 2020 through September 6, 2023

I would like a copy of all audio footage for all phone calls to the Lavallette police department's non-emergency line or to the council from July 24, 2023 through September 6, 2023 concerning the subjects "BONGHOLELEO/Bongholeo", Mikey, Wronko, 1st Amendment, recording, filming, council meeting and common law

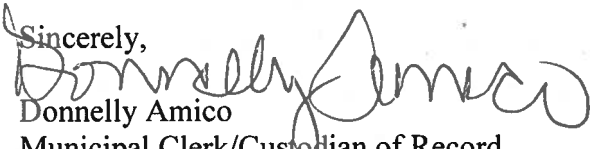
Your request requires additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to fulfill. OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied."

Your request requires an extension of time no later than December 15, 2023.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the [insert name of Agency] to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by

completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding coraplays filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
