Public Post Filters and Tools

Who Can Follow My Page

Followers see your posts in Feed. Use this setting to choose who can follow you.

Public

Each time you post or create a reel or story, you choose which audience you want to share with.

Public post comments

Choose who is allowed to comment on your public posts. People tagged in your public posts and their friends may still be able to comment.

You can get notifications when people start following you and share, like or comment on your public posts.

Public Page Info

Manage who can like or comment on Page information that is always public, including your profile pictures, profile videos, cover photos, featured photos and updates to your short bio.

Off-Facebook Previews

Enable previews when your Public Group posts are shared off of Facebook. Previews may include your username, your profile image and any other content from your original post.

Show most relevant comments first

When comment ranking is turned on, you'll see the most relevant comments for your posts first.

Content moderation

Hide comments containing certain words from your Page

Choose a list of words, phrases or emojis you want to hide from your Page.

Variations of keywords that use numbers, symbols or different spellings are automatically hidden. Example: tree, TREE, tr33, treee, t.r.e.e, #tree. [Learn More](#)
