NARRATIVE

On 01/08/2025, Officer Contreras and I were assigned to work the town council meeting. While working the meeting, I was approached by a male later identified as Victim Christo Makropoulos. Christo advised me that he would like to file a harassment report against a female, later identified as Sonia Alves Viveiros.

Christo stated the following in summary:

Over the past two (2) years, he has been having ongoing issues with

Sonia. Today (01/08/2025), he was attempting to record the town council meeting on his cell phone. While attempting to record the meeting, he accidentally crossed over one (1) of the township barriers. It should be noted that this barrier separates the Edison residents from the township employees, and members of the public are not allowed to cross this barrier. Christo informed me that the reason he went past the barrier was because there was a handicapped individual blocking his walkway, and he was attempting to get a better angle for his recording. After temporarily going past the barrier, Christo stated that Sonia made a comment directed towards him. This comment then led to a brief dispute between both parties. During the course of the verbal dispute, Sonia threatened to get her husband involved. Sonia did not specify as to how her husband would get involved. Christo further stated that he perceived this comment as a threat which, put him in fear for his safety.

After gathering all of this information, I then spoke with a witness later identified as Michael Vintzileos. Michael corroborated Christo's side of the story, and stated that Sonia instigated the entire incident. Michael also mentioned that he did hear Sonia threaten to get her husband involved. Christo was then given a case number and informed on how to obtain a copy of this report. Reference Officer Coppola's report (#25001526) for Sonia's side of the story.
