Please accept this communication in reply to your OPRA request for the following records:

"Any and all logs, visitor sign-in sheets, email correspondences, or digital calendar invites for interviews conducted by Danielle Panizzi (or regarding the hostile work environment investigation) between 01/16/2026 and 03/30/2026. This request explicitly includes any transmittal correspondence, scheduling logs, or completion memos sent between Danielle Panizzi and the Superintendent's Office or Board Counsel regarding the scheduling or execution of said interviews."

Please be advised that any communication between Ms. Panizzi and district staff or representatives constitutes attorney-client communication and attorney work-product and therefore cannot be provided pursuant to OPRA. In that regard, the District is withholding email threads between Machado Law Group and four District employees with various communications occurring on 2/13/26 and 2/19/26. In addition, I refer you to email communication between you and Ms. Panizzi on February 13, 2026, January 30, 2026, January 27, 2026, and January 23, 2026, which are already in your possession, and which may be responsive to your request.

Additionally, please note that OPRA requires a requestor to identify the specific government records sought. A records custodian is not required to conduct research, analyze files, or determine which records may be responsive to a broad request for "any and all" records. Bent v. Township of Stafford Police Department, 381 N.J.Super. 30, 37 (App.Div.2005) (holding that OPRA does not authorize requests for information generally, but rather for identifiable government records); MAG Entertainment, LLC v. Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control, 375 N.J.Super. 534, 546-47 (App.Div.2005) (holding that OPRA does not require a custodian to conduct research or create records in response to a request). In other word, requests seeking all

records related to a broad subject matter without sufficient specificity constitute invalid requests under OPRA. As such, the remainder of your request referring to "any and all" other items does not contain specificity sufficient to identify the government records sought and cannot be processed as submitted. You may submit a revised request identifying specific records.
