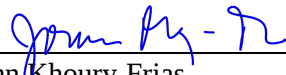
Copies of ALL invoices for all fire extinguisher, kitchen fire suppression and fire alarm services from 2020 to present.

Your request is GRANTED to the extent there are documents in existence. The documents responsive to your request can be found using this [link](#).

Kindly note that if your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the Board's decision to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the GRC by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866)-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their website at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
