It is, therefore, on 09/24/2024 **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that the defendant is sentenced as follows:

This is a simultaneous plea and sentencing, and accordingly, defendant is sentenced as follows:

Amended Count 1: The defendant is sentenced to fines and Restitution.

Defendant is credited with two (2) days of time served.

The court is exercising its discretion by applying the two (2) jail credit days to satisfy monetary penalties, consequently, the \$50 VCCO and \$75 SNSF are deemed satisfied by application of two (2) days jail credit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:12-23.1 and N.J.S.A. 2C:46-2(d).

Defendant is ordered to pay Restitution in the amount of one thousand two hundred forty (\$1240) dollars to the Lakewood Plaza Complex II, located at 154 Martin Luther King Drive, Lakewood, New Jersey.

Defendant is to pay monetary penalties as set forth on Page Two through Probation at a monthly rate of one hundred (\$100) dollars commencing November 1, 2024 and then by the first (1st) day of the month thereafter.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

ON SATURDAY, 07/06/2024, AT APPROXIMATELY 2033 HOURS, I PATROLMAN MATTHEWS #439 RESPONDED TO [REDACTED] FOR THE REPORT OF A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INCIDENT. UPON ARRIVAL, I MET WITH STEVEN I. MCNEILL, AND [REDACTED]. THE PARTIES WERE SEPERATED IN AN ATTEMPT TO GATHER INDEPENDANT STATEMENTS ON THE EVENTS THAT HAD TRANSPIRED. MR. MCNEILL WAS VISIBLY UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF UNKNOWN SUBSTANCES, AND HE SWAYED AS HE STOOD, DISPLAYED SLURRED SPEECH, AND VOMITED AFTER BEING ASKED TO SIT DOWN AND SPEAK WITH RESPONDING OFFICERS. I ATTEMPTED TO INQUIRE ABOUT THE INCIDENT WITH MR. MCNEILL, AND HE STATED THAT HE ARGUES OCCASIONALLY WITH MS. [REDACTED], WHOS MOTHER OVERREACTS ABOUT THIS AND CALLS THE POLICE. HE DENIED ANYTHING PHYSICAL OCCURRING AT ANY POINT.

I THEN SPOKE WITH MS. [REDACTED], WHO ADVISED MR. MCNEILL IS HER EX-BOYFRIEND, AND CAME TO HER RESIDENCE ON 07/03/2024. SHE STATED SHE OBSERVED HIM TO TAKE A "XANAX" PILL, AND WHEN SHE TOLD HIM NOT DO THIS HIS BEHAVIOR CHANGED, AND HE BEGAN ACTING ERRATICALLY. SHE ADVISED BETWEEN 07/03/2024, AND THE TIME OF THE CALL, HE HAS BEEN INTOXICATED, AND COMPLAINING OUT LOUD ABOUT MS. [REDACTED]. SHE STATED ON THE MORNING OF 07/06/2024, MR. MCNEILL WAS LOCKED OUT OF THE RESIDENCE, SPECIFICALLY THE FRONT DOOR, WHICH IS LOCATED IN A COMMON STAIRWELL AREA OF THE APARTMENT BUILDING. SHE STATED MR. MCNEILL FORCED HIS WAY THROUGH THE DOOR, CAUSING DAMAGE TO THE MOLDING AROUND THE DOOR, AND PREVENTING THE DOOR FROM LATCHING WITHOUT THE DEADBOLT LOCKED.
