**OLD BUSINESS:**

**1. DRESS CODE POLICY -**

**NEW BUSINESS**

- 1. GRAFFITI -** Teachers have been made aware of a rise in racist/anti semetic graffiti in the student restrooms. What is the administration doing to prevent this throughout the building/district? It seems that efforts are being made to keep these incidents secretive, instead of calling them out with either an announcement over the loudspeaker and/or a post on Schoology & stating that this behavior won't be tolerated.

*There has been an uptick in destruction in bathrooms, none of which has been anti semetic or racist. Students who have caused the destruction have been reprimanded. The maintenance department has repainted immediately after destruction. Everyone's role is critical right now, whether it's a duty or in the classroom; do not let students out of class for long periods of time. Be vigilant.*

- 2. CLASSROOM CLEANING/WHITEBOARDS -** The current cleaning company is not meeting expectations in cleaning classrooms; specifically floors, whiteboards & windows.

*The Administration & Facilities Department are aware of cleaning company issues. The more we document the more pressure we can put on the cleaning company. Continue entering items in Schooldude. At this time, our facilities department is also short staffed.*

- 3. FACULTY PARKING LOT -** Parents are once again parking in the faculty parking lot at the end of the day to pick up students.

*It was asked if a truck can be parked at the entrance of the Faculty lot to block the parents from pulling in. Facilities are short handed right now. Travis will send out an E blast reminder to the community that they can park in the senior lot.*
