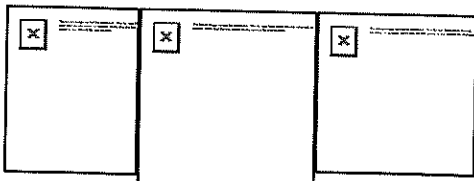

Kristine,

Attached is our most recent reminder and policy update which was coincidentally issued before we knew we had anyone who was sick. For public safety personnel if you can point to a work related exposure we submit to Bergen Risk as with any other work related exposure or injury. If the officer is exposed off duty or has not been working within the time frame of exposure (in other words there is no way to tell) it would be sick time.

Other than shift change and roll call we seldom have more than one officer in any office at any time, on occasion passing in the hallway. Necessary enhanced precautions are taken when dealing with custodial arrests. We have single officer patrols and it is very rare in the situation where we would have two officers in the same patrol vehicle. The bulk of our officers are not office workers, do not have offices, and unless engaged in responding to a call for service we basically work by ourselves. With the 24/7 schedule we are unlike other Borough Departments where most work at the same time. The reality of our workplace is not comparable to any other borough employee. Unfortunately, the downside to any public safety organization is that we must respond and provide assistance to those individuals who are ill, be it Covid 19 or anything else. Often those that we arrest or have the necessity to field contact are not people who generally take good care of themselves and often have visible illness or infections. This was the case well before Covid 19. It is also sadly not uncommon that people will attack officers with bodily fluids or bite them. We also will have situations where our officers and ambulance corps members will be doing CPR on people in the community who have Covid 19. Those in Public Safety who by our very nature run into danger while others are running away tend to take these things into stride and protect ourselves to that degree which may be possible.

After January 1 when we are back to the state mandated training that we must send officers to I will be very interested to see what precautions are going to be put in place to protect officers who are attending this training. Most notably since there is a physical aspect to the training. Not to mention how the Academy will be coordinating training concerns for our new officer who will begin basic training. I have expressed concerns to both the AG's Office and BCPO that the majority of our officers who have contracted COVID-19 have done so during training not under the immediate control of the department. The prior size of these classes may need to be reexamined and reconciled against the state mandates which don't seem to take COVID-19 into account. But, all of that is well beyond our control.

After today I will be out of the office until January 3, both lieutenants are available in my absence and I am only a phone call away if needed.

Mayor and Public Safety,

Consistent with what's going on nationwide we have had some Covid 19 issues within the GRPD, this includes breakthrough cases of the fully vaccinated. As a result of a training exercise conducted at the New Jersey State police academy in Sea Girt we have one officer who was confirmed positive with Covid and two other officers were exhibiting symptoms and are awaiting test results. Luckily all are moderate to minor cases. The appropriate contact tracing has been done with appropriate quarantines and a total of nine sworn and civilian personnel are being tested as a precaution. We offered testing even to personnel who may not have actually been considered as exposed. I should point out that the testing site in Glen Rock has gone out of their way to accommodate us.

Of course all of this comes as we were leading to Christmas and at minimum staffing to begin with. As an immediate result we have incurred about 66 hours of overtime, hopefully no one else will test positive and that will be the end of it.

Jackie,

Lieut. Riggio brought me up to speed today on where we are standing with officers out sick or otherwise quarantined. He actually kept me fully up to speed while I was away, but today's conversation was far more in depth. We also did a roughly 45 minute conference call with Rose from Bergen Risk. I subsequently spoke to Lenora, but also want to make sure we keep you in the loop.

Bergen Risk will be accepting a claim for anyone who was exposed at work and became ill or was involuntarily put out of work on quarantine for more than seven days. Upon review it appears they will most likely reimburse after seven days back to the first full day they were out. Rose has been dealing with numerous police departments all of which are pretty much in the same position. We also agreed to provide her with an overview email, in addition to the notice of first claim filings online, which you will be copied on. Once a final determination has been made, we will go from there. Bergen Risk will also provide us with assistance in expediting Covid testing for our officers.

Over the last couple of weeks, we have seen a spike in medical calls and lift assists which our officers have responded to along with the ambulance corps (and the case of a 500 pound individual the fire department as well). A considerable number of the citizens we are being called to assist are in fact Covid positive. While all necessary precautions are being taken, the risk of exposures and illness to our emergency services has increased. To that end, we have redoubled our efforts to provide all necessary protections to our personnel.

The Bergen County Prosecutor's Office and the Attorney General's office are now collecting number statewide for officers were out ill or quarantined. If we go down the same road, we did in 2020, I expect that in AG's directive concerning law enforcement staffing, quarantine protocols, and operational limitations will be forthcoming. No doubt, this will depend upon how the numbers go statewide moving forward. So time will tell.

Kristine,

Attached is our most recent reminder and policy update which was coincidentally issued before we knew we had anyone who was sick. For public safety personnel if you can point to a work related exposure we submit to Bergen Risk as with any other work related exposure or injury. If the officer is exposed off duty or has not been working within the time frame of exposure (in other words there is no way to tell) it would be sick time.

Other than shift change and roll call we seldom have more than one officer in any office at any time, on occasion passing in the hallway. Necessary enhanced precautions are taken when dealing with custodial arrests. We have single officer patrols and it is very rare in the situation where we would have two officers in the same patrol vehicle. The bulk of our officers are not office workers, do not have offices, and unless engaged in responding to a call for service we basically work by ourselves. With the 24/7 schedule we are unlike other Borough Departments where most work at the same time. The reality of our workplace is not comparable to any other borough employee. Unfortunately, the downside to any public safety organization is that we must respond and provide assistance to those individuals who are ill, be it Covid 19 or anything else. Often those that we arrest or have the necessity to field contact are not people who generally take good care of themselves and often have visible illness or infections. This was the case well before Covid 19. It is also sadly not uncommon that people will attack officers with bodily fluids or bite them. We also will have situations where our officers and ambulance corps members will be doing CPR on people in the community who have Covid 19. Those in Public Safety who by our very nature run into danger while others are running away tend to take these things into stride and protect ourselves to that degree which may be possible.

After January 1 when we are back to the state mandated training that we must send officers to I will be very interested to see what precautions are going to be put in place to protect officers who are attending this training. Most notably since there is a physical aspect to the training. Not to mention how the Academy will be coordinating training concerns for our new officer who will begin basic training. I have expressed concerns to both the AG's Office and BCPO that the majority of our officers who have contracted COVID-19 have done so during training not under the immediate control of the department. The prior size of these classes may need to be reexamined and reconciled against the state mandates which don't seem to take COVID-19 into account. But, all of that is well beyond our control.

After today I will be out of the office until January 3, both lieutenants are available in my absence and I am only a phone call away if needed.

Consistent with what's going on nationwide we have had some Covid 19 issues within the GRPD, this includes breakthrough cases of the fully vaccinated. As a result of a training exercise conducted at the New Jersey State police academy in Sea Girt we have one officer who was confirmed positive with Covid and two other officers were exhibiting symptoms and are awaiting test results. Luckily all are moderate to minor cases. The appropriate contact tracing has been done with appropriate quarantines and a total of nine sworn and civilian personnel are being tested as a precaution. We offered testing even to personnel who may not have actually been considered as exposed. I should point out that the testing site in Glen Rock has gone out of their way to accommodate us.

Of course all of this comes as we were leading to Christmas and at minimum staffing to begin with. As an immediate result we have incurred about 66 hours of overtime, hopefully no one else will test positive and that will be the end of it.

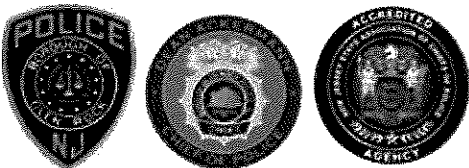

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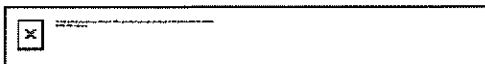

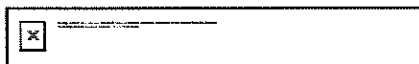

Jackie,

Lieut. Riggio brought me up to speed today on where we are standing with officers out sick or otherwise quarantined. He actually kept me fully up to speed while I was away, but today's conversation was far more in depth. We also did a roughly 45 minute conference call with Rose from Bergen Risk. I subsequently spoke to Lenora, but also want to make sure we keep you in the loop.

Bergen Risk will be accepting a claim for anyone who was exposed at work and became ill or was involuntarily put out of work on quarantine for more than seven days. Upon review it appears they will most likely reimburse after seven days back to the first full day they were out. Rose has been dealing with numerous police departments all of which are pretty much in the same position. We also agreed to provide her with an overview email, in addition to the notice of first claim filings online, which you will be copied on. Once a final determination has been made, we will go from there. Bergen Risk will also provide us with assistance in expediting Covid testing for our officers.

Over the last couple of weeks, we have seen a spike in medical calls and lift assists which our officers have responded to along with the ambulance corps (and the case of a 500 pound individual the fire department as well). A considerable number of the citizens we are being called to assist are in fact Covid positive. While all necessary precautions are being taken, the risk of exposures and illness to our emergency services has increased. To that end, we have redoubled our efforts to provide all necessary protections to our personnel.

The Bergen County Prosecutor's Office and the Attorney General's office are now collecting number statewide for officers who are out ill or quarantined. If we go down the same road, we did in 2020, I expect that in AG's directive concerning law enforcement staffing, quarantine protocols, and operational limitations will be forthcoming. No doubt, this will depend upon how the numbers go statewide moving forward. So time will tell.

Please do not hesitate to reach out to Frank or I with any questions.

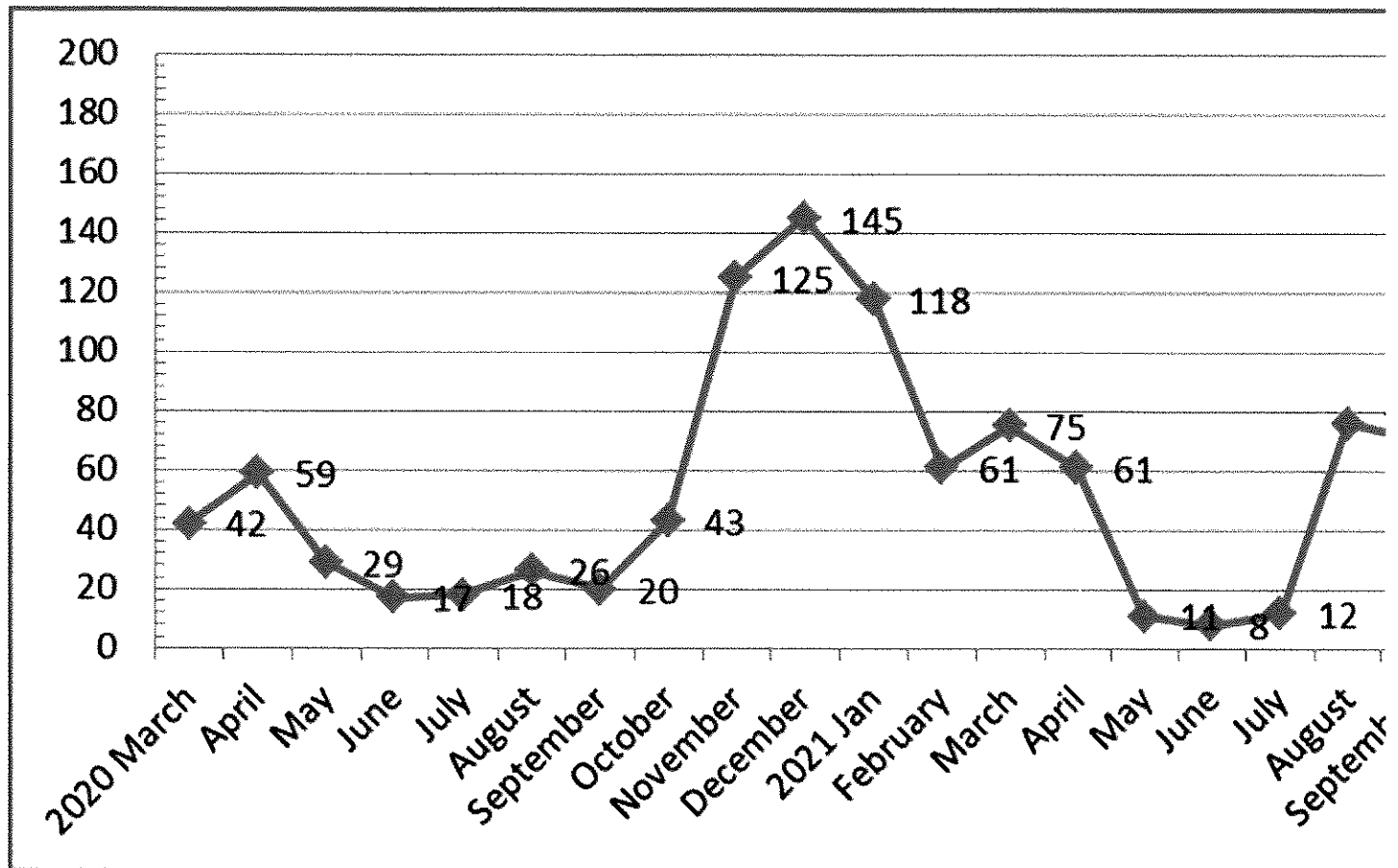

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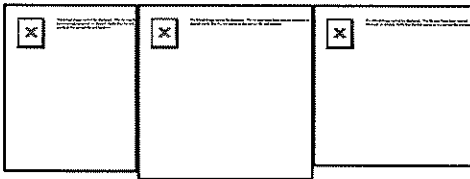
