You requested that the Township reimburse you for legal fees incurred in your defense of the matter captioned Independent Fire Company #1, Andrew Simonsick Sr. et als. v. State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, Township of Maple Shade, Susan Danson, et als., filed under Docket No. BUR-L- 2105-23 in the Superior Court, Burlington County Vicinage.

The Township Council has agreed to provide reimbursement for your personal defense costs so long as there is no indication that: 1) any act or omission by you was outside of the scope of your employment or official duties; 2) any act or failure to act by you was because of actual fraud, willful misconduct or actual malice; and 3) the Township's compensation of your defense creates a conflict of interest between the Township and you. The Township reserves the right to terminate this agreement at any time and without court determination that any of the above circumstances have been conclusively established.

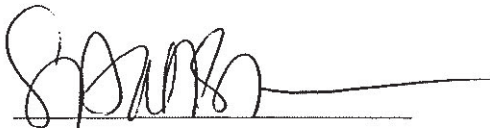

You shall promptly provide the Township with invoicing from your attorney and such other documentation as the Chief Financial Officer or Township Attorney deem necessary.
